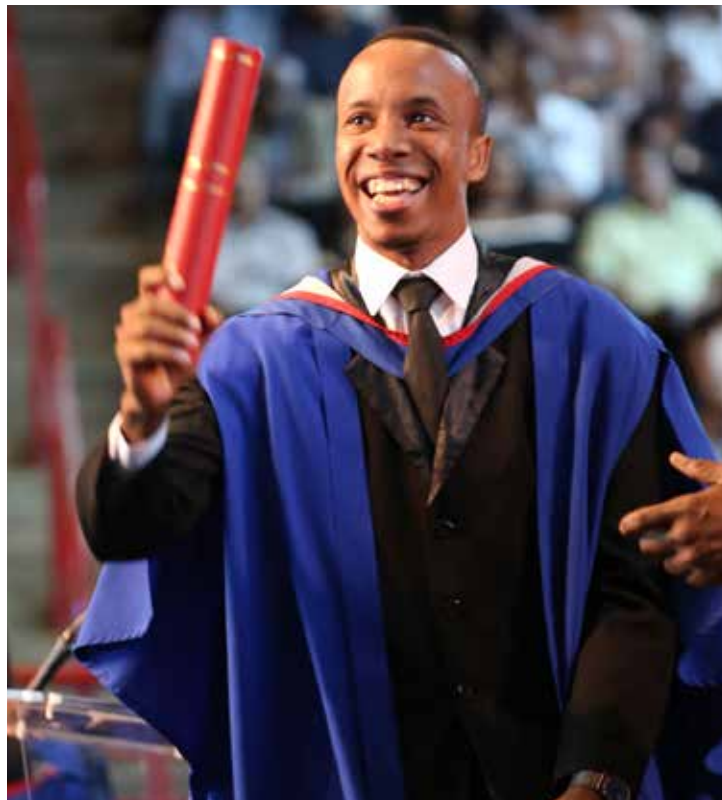

About the Digest

Welcome to The University of the West Indies, St. Augustine Campus's Student Statistical Digest for the academic year 2017/2018. It presents a comprehensive collection of official relevant, historical and current data on the student population. These statistics are being presented to the Campus Council and the wider public in a format where the statistics cover a five-year academic period (2013/2014 to 2017/18) and in certain areas, data for Semester 1 of the current academic year 2018/2019. The report examines student admissions, enrolment, graduation and departmental and faculty trends. Recently added, are a series of new dimensions including student applications, offers, new admissions, and time to graduate. Of interest, are some key empirical findings emerging from the annual Graduate Tracer Survey of the first degree graduating class.

This report is the result of a collaborative effort between the Campus Office of Planning and Institutional Research (COPIR) and the Office of the Campus Registrar, with key input from other units namely, the Student Admissions section, the Office of Graduate Studies and Research (OGSR) and the Examinations section of The UWI St. Augustine Campus. We are grateful as well for the support of the Campus Information Technology Services (CITS) and the Faculties.



Introduction

The University of the West Indies is a four-campus tertiary education institution supported by 17 contributing countries. It offer certificates, diplomas and degrees at both the undergraduate and postgraduate levels in various fields of study to students from around the region and internationally. The St. Augustine Campus in Trinidad was born in 1960 out of the Imperial College of Tropical Agriculture (ICTA) and currently provides higher education to over 17,000 students. The St. Augustine Campus houses seven faculties: Humanities & Education, Social Sciences, Medical Sciences, Law, Science and Technology, Food and Agriculture and Engineering and also hosts a range of research units, centres and institutes. The UWI, St. Augustine continues to be dedicated to teaching and learning, research and innovation and to the development of the Caribbean region.

This report on The University of the West Indies St. Augustine Campus Student Statistical Digest is a presentation to the St. Augustine Campus Council for the academic year 2017/2018. The statistical information presented provides quantitative measures and utilises descriptive statistics to illustrate current and historical data on student participation and performance for the period 2013/2014 to 2017/2018. It also provides a snapshot of student statistics for Semester 1 of the current academic year, 2018/2019. The report delivers information on the following areas:

- a. **Student statistics over a five-year period in respect of Student Applications Admissions, Enrolment and Graduation**
- b. **Faculty statistical comparisons**
- c. **A demographic profile of students by nationality, age and sex**
- d. **Student enrolment at the programme level**
- e. **Trending data on average time to graduate**

This document was produced with data that were generated as of January 2018. As such, any updates made to data subsequent to the aforementioned date would not be reflected in the statistics presented.

Definitions of Key Terms

Applications	The number of applications received by individuals (head count)
Contributing Students	Students whose nations of origin include the UWI 12 +1 as well as Barbados and Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago
Evening	Students who are registered in Certificate/Diploma or Degree programmes which are offered specifically in the Evening University
Full-Time	Registered students who carry the complete load of course credits associated with their university programme for that semester/academic year
Graduation Time	The average time taken to complete a programme in calendar years
Nationals	Students whose nation of origin is Trinidad and Tobago.
New Admissions	Registered students who are new first time entrants and new first time transfers to the University.
No College Designated	Students who are enrolled in Summer Programmes who are not registered with a particular faculty
Non-Contributing	Students whose nation of origin includes all nations other than the UWI 12+1, Barbados, Jamaica or Trinidad and Tobago.
Not Identifiable (NI)	A term used to categorise any area where no data was entered in the data repository
Offers	The number of applicants (head count) given institutional acceptance (offers)
Off Campus	Students enrolled in programmes that are administered at UWI-affiliated institutions and are not located on the St. Augustine Campus.
On Campus	Students who attend classes on the St. Augustine or Mt. Hope campuses and are in pursuit of a degree, certificate or diploma programme.
Other Students	Students enrolled in courses undeclared and summer programmes
Part-Time	Registered students who carry less than the complete load of courses associated with their university programme for that semester/academic year
Postgraduate/Graduate (PG)	Students enrolled in Higher Degree programmes at the St. Augustine campus which lead to the acquisition of a qualification beyond a first degree such as the PG Diploma, Taught Master, Master of Philosophy, Doctorate etc.
Pre-University Students	Students enrolled in the Pre-Science and Pre-Health programmes
Programme	The course of study for which the student has been admitted into the University. This pertains to Undergraduate (BSc, BA, B.Ed.), Certificates, Diplomas, Advanced Diplomas and Higher Degrees (MA, MSc, MPhil, PhD, etc.).
Qualifying	A student reading for courses to qualify for entry to a graduate programme
Registration/Enrolment	The process by which students, upon acceptance into a given faculty and programme at the University, give written notification of the courses which they wish to pursue during the current semester/academic year. Different aspects of the registration data are represented in the tables. For the purpose of this document, this includes both on and off campus students and excludes other students.
Retention Rate	The percentage of students from a specific entry cohort who re-enroll for a second year of study.
Specially Admitted	Students admitted to the University under special circumstances, such as to attend selected courses not associated with a particular programme.
Student Session	Students who are either enrolled in a full time, part time, evening, and summer basis.
Summer	Students enrolled to pursue courses during the summer semester, which occurs from June to July of the academic year.
Undergraduate (UG)	Students enrolled at the St. Augustine campus in programmes, which lead to the award of a Certificate, UG Diploma or First Degree.
Undeclared	At UWI 'Undeclared' is a level, in addition to UG, GR, CT, etc. used to differentiate students in a non-degree or certificate programme, such as the Pre Science (N1) programme or Pre-Health Professions Programme [PHPP].

Section 1. Trends in the number of Applicants, Offers and New Admissions

When observing data collected for just over a decade, the number of Applicants, has shown an increasing trend having peaked in 2011/2012 at 13,515 but having declined by 6.3% over the period 2012/2013 to 2016/2017. The number of offers made, steadily rose over the time period examined until it experienced a minor decline in 2017/2018. In terms of selectivity, the rate has been an estimated 71% in the last 5 year period. Yield rates reflecting new admissions have in contrast, been on the decline from 80.5% to 69.3% in the same period, suggesting a lower rate of admissions to offers made. New student admissions at the postgraduate level rose to a peak of 1854 students in 2016/2017 from 5% in 2013/2014, but experienced a decline of 10% in the academic year 2017/2018. In contrast, new student admissions at the undergraduate level experienced a declining trend in the comparative period under review of 16.3%.

Figure 1.1: Trends in the Applicants, Offers and New Admissions 2008/2009 – 2018/2019

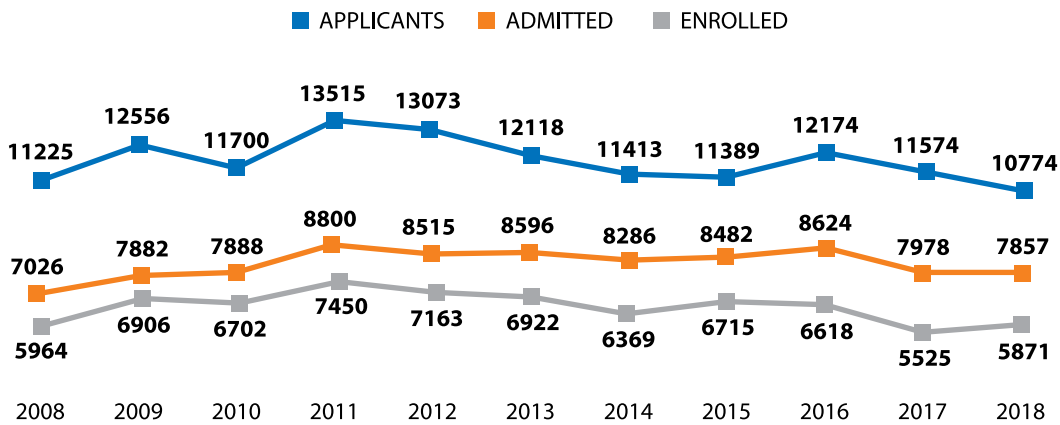


Figure 1.2: Trends in the proportion of applicants who were offered 2008/2009 – 2018/2019

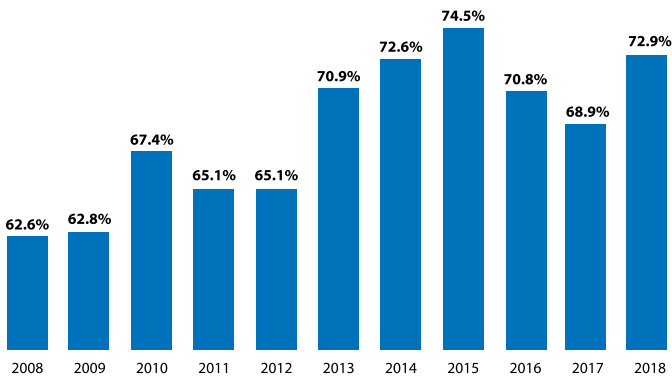
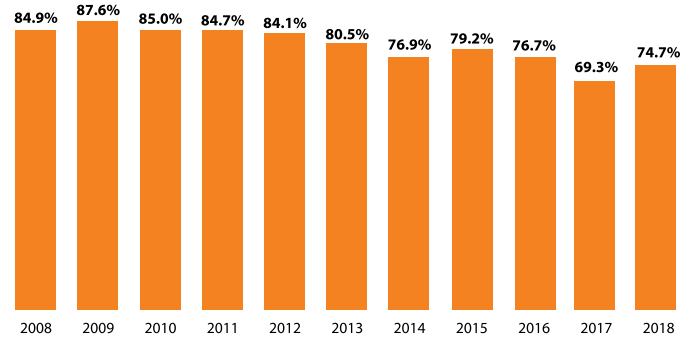


Figure 1.3: Trends in the proportion of offered applicants who enrolled 2008/2009 – 2018/2019



Section 2. Total Enrolment Trends for UG and PG Students 2013/2014 – 2017/2018

Student enrolment is representative of new and continuing students at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels in the seven faculties of Engineering, Food and Agriculture, Humanities and Education, Law, Medical Sciences, Science and Technology and Social Sciences.

On average, the undergraduate population and postgraduate population constitutes 67.1% and 32.7%, respectively of total enrolment. The trends have however indicated a progressive decline in total student enrolment between the period 2013/2014 to 2017/2018, which has resulted in an overall reduction of 13% (See **Table 2.2**). Pre-University and Other students make up less than 1% of student enrolment. It is observed that the number of Pre-University students who comprise mainly of the Pre-Science students in the faculty of Science and Technology, has increased significantly in the comparable period by 125%.

Enrolment by full-time and part-time status is indicated in **Table 2.3** and suggests that enrolment on a part-time basis declined by 44% at the undergraduate level and by 17% at the postgraduate level, with a marginal spill over to the Evening University (EU). The declining enrolment in the Evening University was further impacted in 2017/2018 when the campus reverted to registering students on a full-time and part-time basis only, while phasing out the existing configuration of the EU.

Section 3 – Student Demographic Trends for UG and PG Students 2013/2014 – 2017/2018

In terms of overall trends in the demographic profile of the student population, for the period 2013/14 to 2017/2018, the following were observed:

- Females continue to outnumber males at all levels of enrolment at The UWI St. Augustine Campus by a ratio of 1.5:1.
- The majority of the undergraduate student population is represented in the age cohort of 24 years and under, with the majority of the postgraduate population between the ages of 25 and 34 years old.
- Students who were nationals of Trinidad and Tobago comprised an annual average of 91% of the student enrolment. On average, those students whose nationality were from the contributing countries represented 97% while those from non-contributing countries were only 3%.

For the purpose of **Table 3.1** below, the figure for Total Enrolment, situated at the top of the table comprises of both Pre-University students and Other students. All other tables in this section will show analysis for the Undergraduate and Postgraduate student populations only.

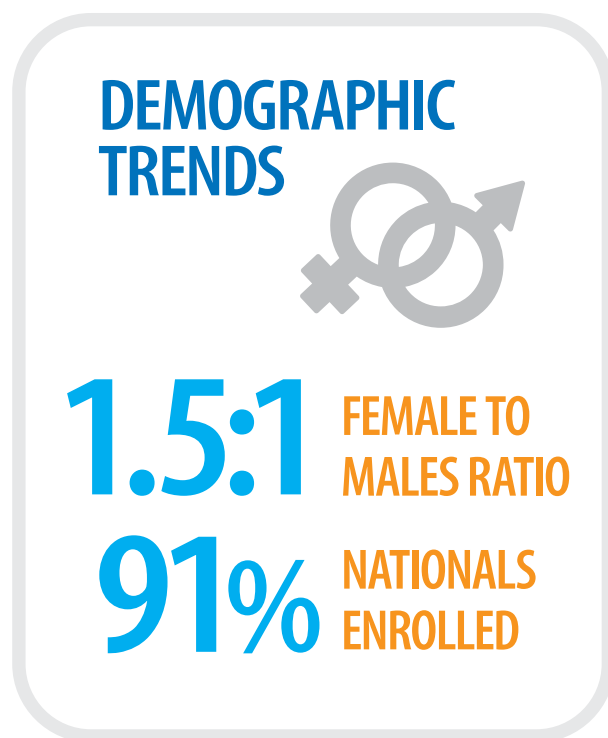
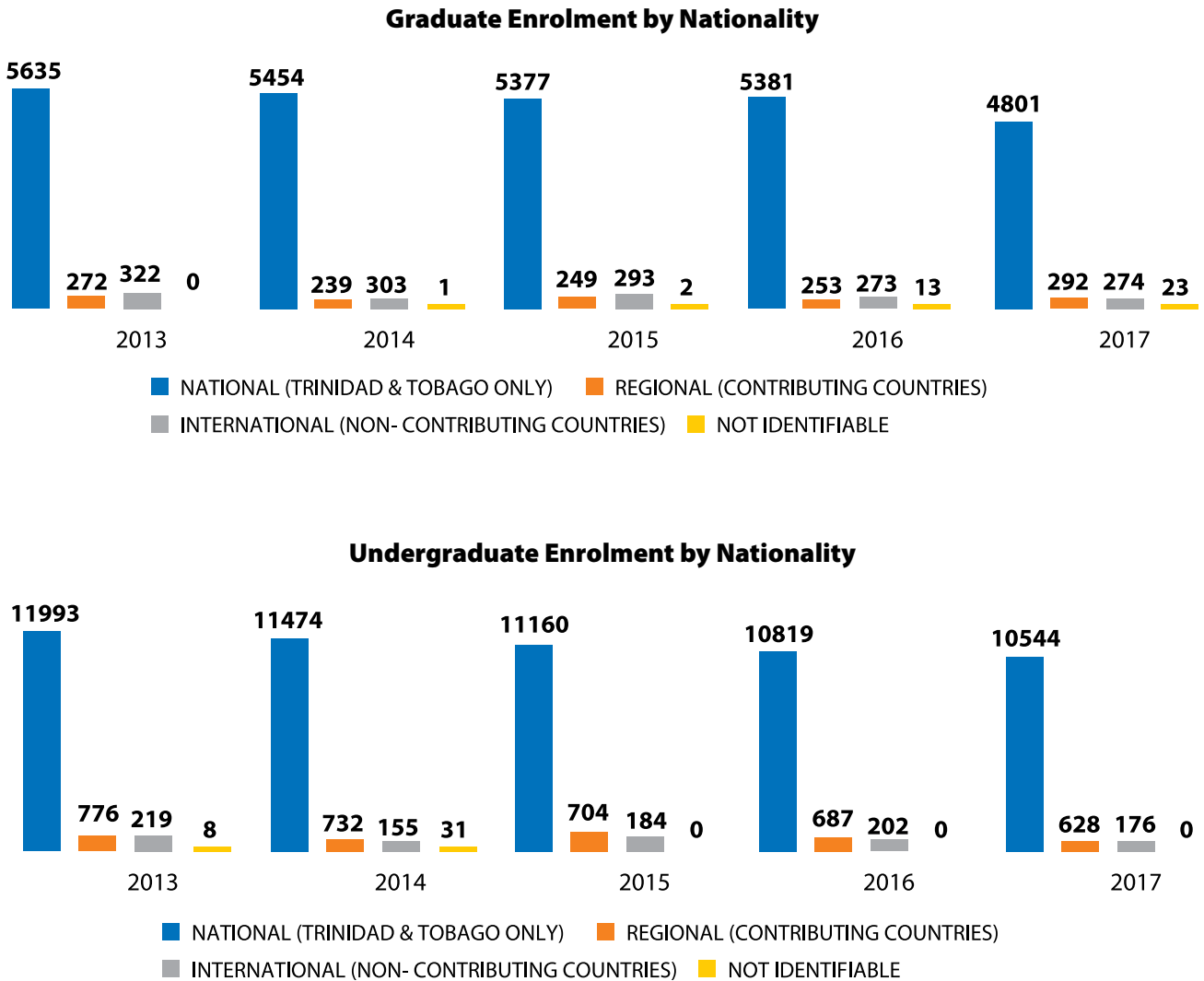

Section 4 – Undergraduate and Postgraduate Faculty Trends

At the level of faculty, the following observations were made for undergraduate and postgraduate student enrolment:

- The faculty of Social Sciences continues to be the largest faculty, accounting for approximately one third of the student population. The faculties of Medical Sciences, Science & Technology and Engineering, account for an approximate 14% to 15% each of all students enrolled.
- In the comparative period 2013/2014 to 2017/2018, total enrolment in the faculties of Engineering, Food and Agriculture, Humanities and Education, and Social Sciences declined by -18.5%, -20.3%, -21.6% and -19.7%, respectively. In contrast, there was growth in the same period in the faculties of Law, Medical Sciences and Science and Technology, which registered an increase of 44.2%, 0.5% and 1.0% respectively.
- The highest proportion of postgraduate enrolment is in the faculty of Social Sciences which in 2017/2018 represents 40% of the total. This is followed by Engineering and Humanities and Education at 18% and 16% respectively.

Figure 4.1: Undergraduate Enrolment by Faculty 2013/2014 – 2017/2018

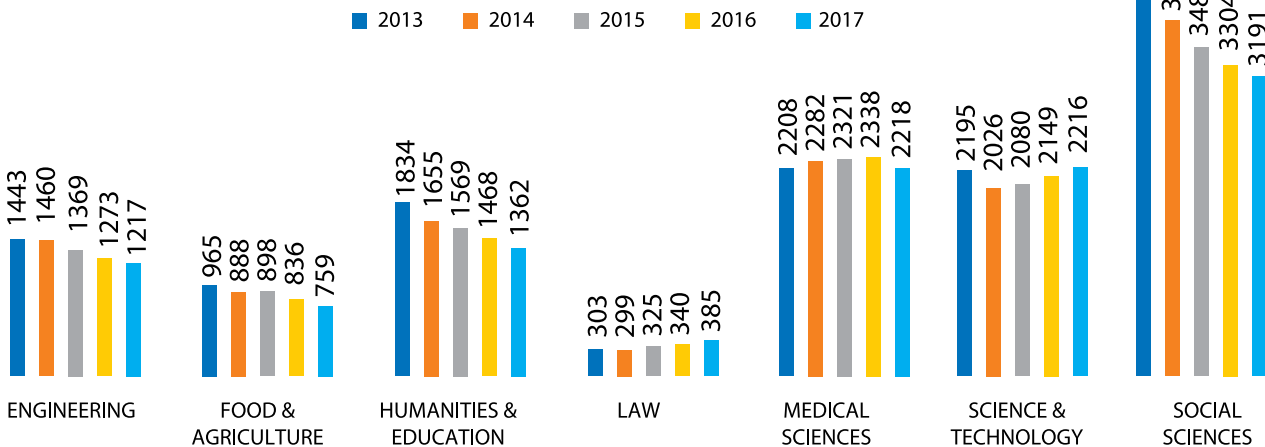
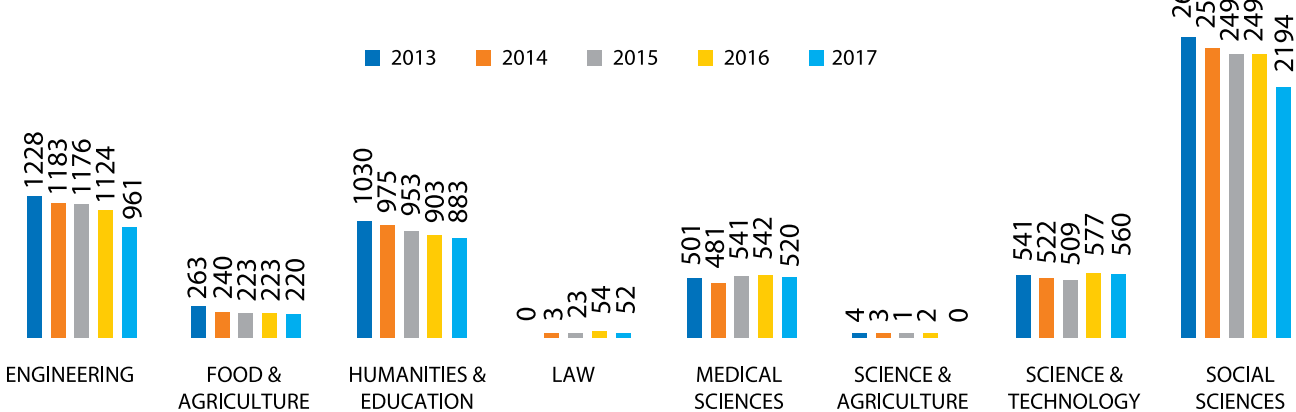


Figure 4.2: Postgraduate Enrolment by Faculty 2013/2014 – 2017/2018

Section 5 – Undergraduate and Postgraduate Graduation Trends

This section provides data on graduate output in respect of demographics, faculty and degree honours and graduate throughput. Highlighted below are some observations related to graduate output over the period 2013/2014 to 2017/2018:

- A total of 4084 persons graduated in 2017/2018, of which 67.5% were first degree graduates and 32.5% were postgraduates.
- In terms of sex, females outnumbered males at both the Undergraduate and Postgraduate levels, with the sex ratio remaining virtually unchanged at an approximate 2:1 female to male graduate output ratio over the period examined.
- In 2017/2018, the highest level of graduate output by programme included the MBBS Medicine and Surgery, BSc Medical Sciences, BSc Management Studies and LLB Law, and BSc Mechanical Engineering. At the postgraduate level those include MSc Strategic Leadership & Management, MBA Business Administration, MSc Occupational & Environmental Safety & Health, M.ED Education and MSc Project Management.
- Females also typically took less time to graduate than males across the time period with Females in the 2017/2018 academic year taking on average 3.55 years to graduate and males taking 3.63 years.

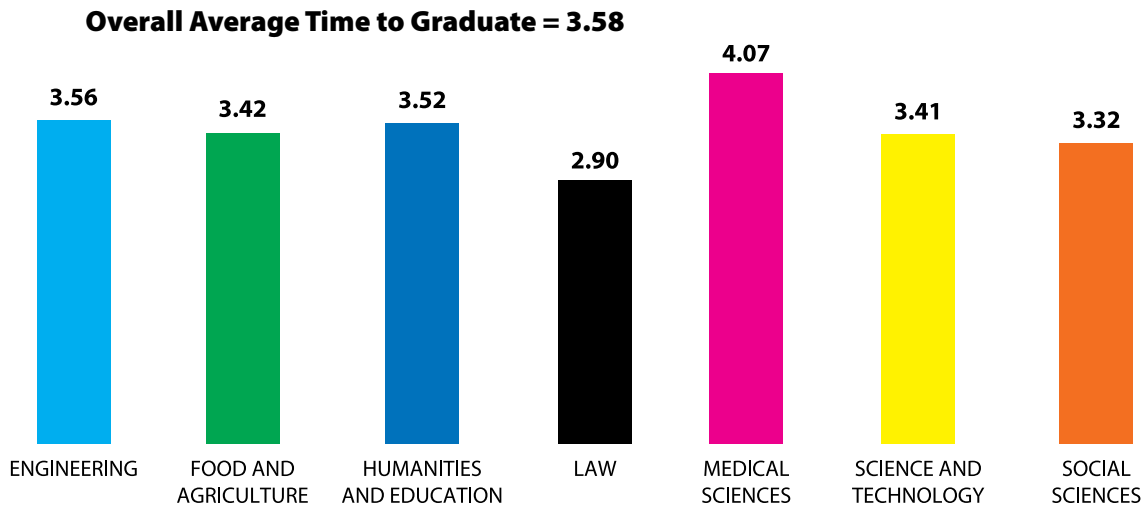

Section 6 – 2016/2017 Graduate Tracer Survey Highlights

The charts below represent an excerpt from the Graduate Tracer Survey (GTS) 2016/17. The GTS is an annual survey conducted by the Campus Office of Planning and Institutional Research on first degree graduates one year after graduating from The UWI. The study analyses the feedback received on the experience of the graduate in relation to their employment outcomes and their UWI programme and attempts to observe trends on the Institution's capacity to prepare the distinctive UWI graduate. The survey was responded to by 30.5% of graduates from the undergraduate class.

For the 2016/2017 period, survey findings showed that graduate employment was 66%, declining from 75% when compared to the earlier survey of 2015/2016. An estimated 5% of the respondents reported being self-employed. At least 54% of the graduates surveyed reported that they were employed in the public sector. The main areas of employment activity were in the fields of Financial and Insurance activities, Education or Healthcare and Social Services. An estimated fifty percent (50%) of respondents earned a monthly salary less than \$7000, with average time taken to find employment being approximately five months.

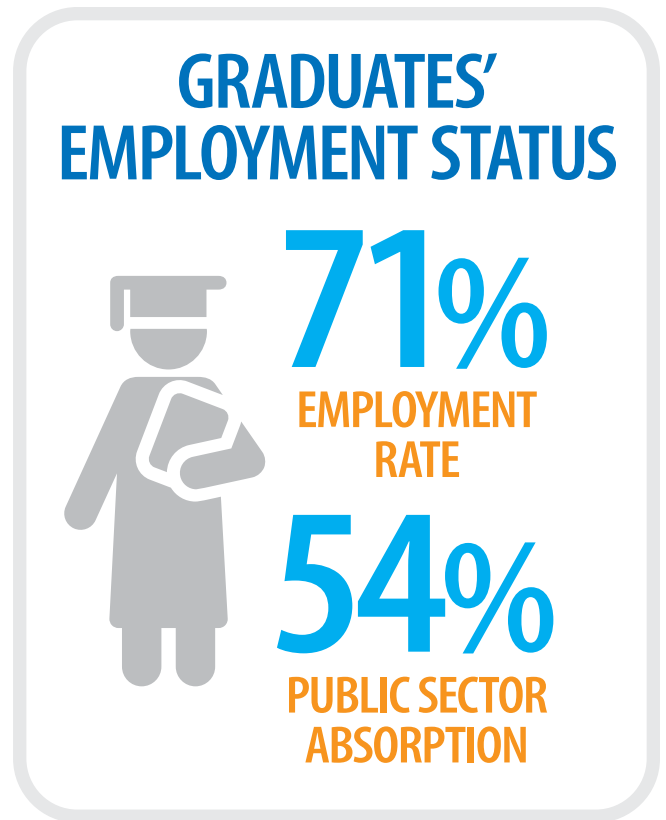
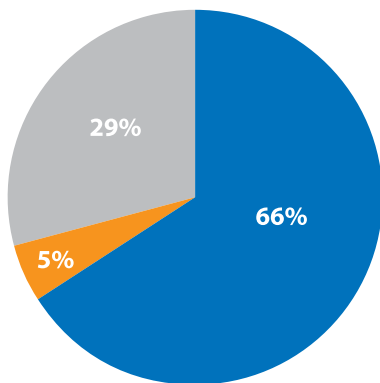
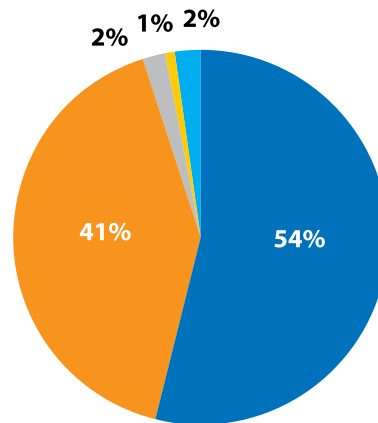

Reasons for Graduates' Unemployment

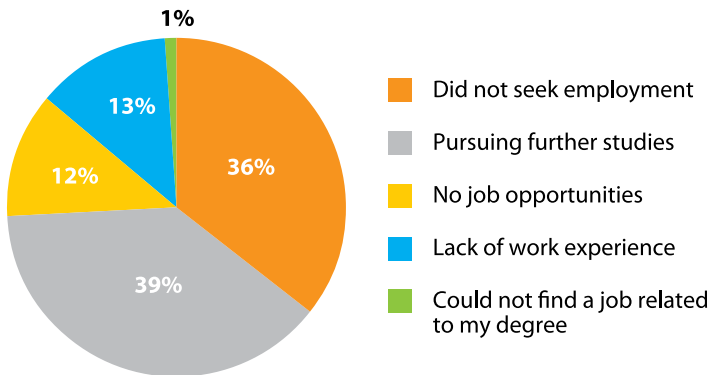

Major Areas of Economic Activity of Graduates

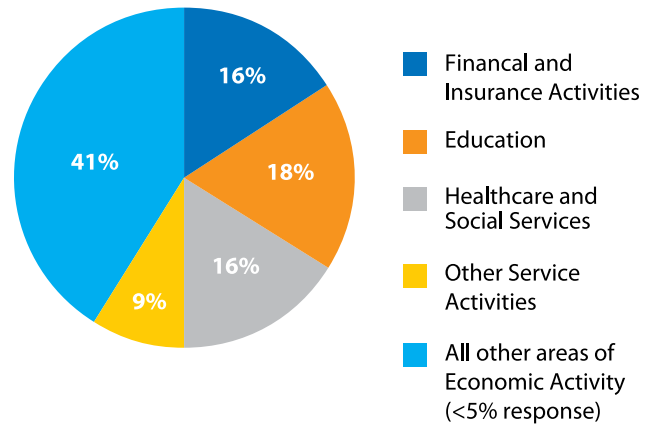


Figure 6.5: Graduates' Gross Monthly Salary

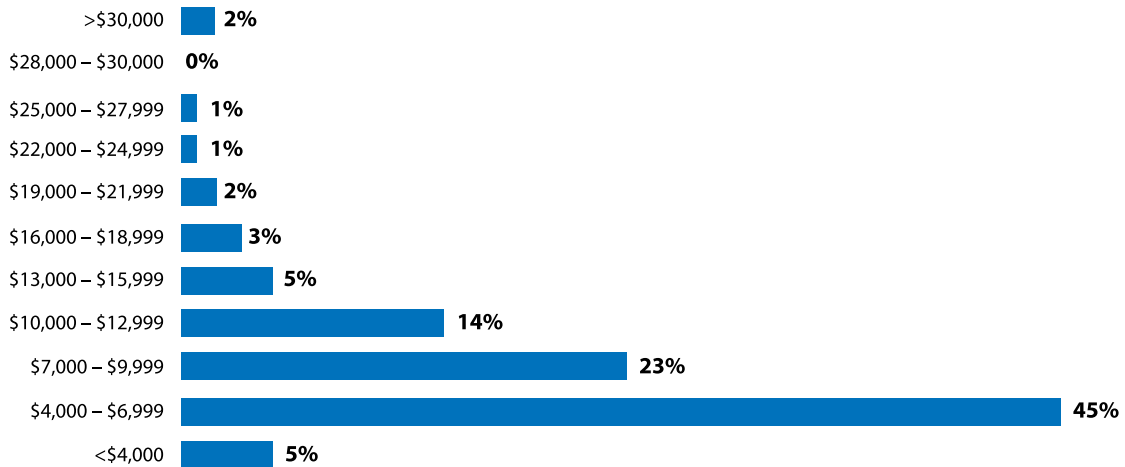
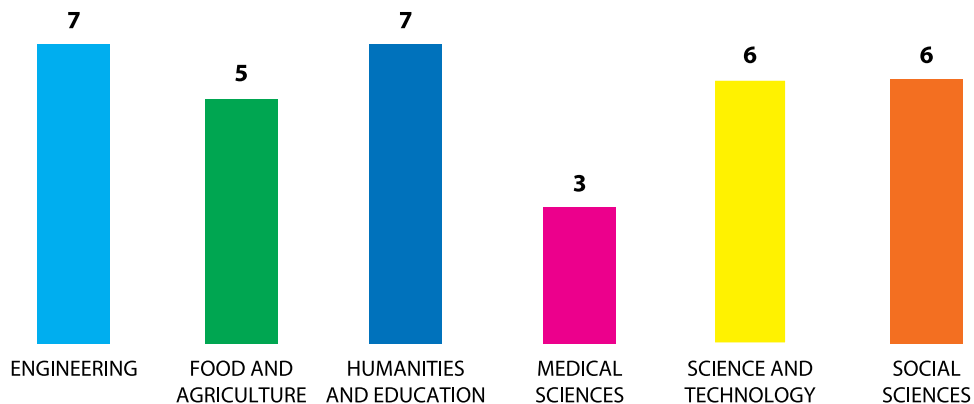


Figure 6.6: Average Time taken to Find Employment
