About the Digest

The University of the West Indies, St. Augustine Campus presents The Campus Student Statistical Digest for the academic year 2018/2019. The Digest presents a comprehensive collection of official relevant historical and current data on the student population. These statistics cover a five-year academic period (2014/2015 to 2018/2019) and in certain areas, data for Semester 1 of the current academic year 2019/20. The report examines student admissions, enrolment, graduation and departmental and faculty trends. Also, highlighted are trends in student applications, offers and admissions.

This report is the result of a collaborative effort between the Campus Office of Planning and Institutional Research (COPIR) and the Office of the Campus Registrar. We are grateful as well for the support of the Campus Information Technology Service (CITS) and the Faculties.



Introduction

The University of the West Indies is a four-campus tertiary education institution supported by 17 contributing countries. It offers undergraduate and postgraduate degrees in various fields of study to students from around the region and internationally. The St. Augustine Campus in Trinidad was born in 1960 out of the Imperial College of Tropical Agriculture (ICTA) and currently provides higher education to over 17,000 students. The St. Augustine Campus houses eight faculties: Humanities & Education, Social Sciences, Medical Sciences, Law, Science and Technology, Food and Agriculture and Engineering and the newest being the Faculty of Sport. It also hosts a range of research units, centres and institutes. The UWI, St. Augustine continues to be dedicated to teaching and learning, research and innovation and to the development of the Caribbean region.

This report on The University of the West Indies St. Augustine campus is a presentation to the St. Augustine Campus Council for the academic year 2018/2019. The statistical information presented provides quantitative measures and utilises descriptive statistics to illustrate current and historical data on student participation for the period 2014/2015 to 2018/2019. It also provides a snapshot of student statistics for Semester 1 of the current academic year, 2019/20. The report delivers information on the following areas:

- a. **Student statistics over a five-year period in respect of Student Applications Admissions, Enrolment and Graduation**
- b. **Faculty statistical comparisons**
- c. **A demographic profile of students by nationality, age and sex**
- d. **Student enrolment at the programme level**

This document was produced with data that were generated as of November 2019. As such, any updates made to data subsequent to the aforementioned date would not be reflected in the statistics presented.

Definitions of Key Terms and Concepts

Applications	The number of applications received by individuals (head count)
Contributing Students	Students whose nationality include the UWI 12 +1 as well as Barbados and Jamaica and Trinidad &Tobago
Evening	Students who are registered in Certificate/Diploma or Degree programmes which are offered specifically in the Evening University
Full-Time	Registered students who carry the complete load of course credits associated with their university programme for that semester/academic year
Nationals	Students whose country of nationality is Trinidad and Tobago.
New Admissions	Registered students who are new first time entrants to the University.
No College Designated	Students who are in enrolled in Summer Programmes who are not registered with a particular faculty
Non-Contributing	Students whose nationality includes all nations other than the UWI 12+1, Barbados, Jamaica or Trinidad and Tobago.
Not Identifiable (NI)	Used to categorised any area where no data was entered in the data repository
Offers	The number of applicants (Head count) given institutional acceptance (offers)
Off Campus	Students enrolled in programmes that are administered at UWI-affiliated institutions and are not located on the St. Augustine Campus.
On Campus	Students who attend classes on the St. Augustine or Mt. Hope campuses and are in pursuit of a degree, certificate or diploma programme.
Other Students	Students enrolled in courses undeclared and summer programmes
Part-Time	Registered students who carry less than the complete load of courses associated with their university programme for that semester/academic year
Postgraduate/Graduate (PG)	Students enrolled in Higher Degree programmes at the St. Augustine campus which lead to the acquisition of a qualification beyond a first degree such as the PG Diploma, Taught Master, Master of Philosophy, Doctorate etc.
Pre-University Students	Students enrolled in the Pre-Science and Pre-Health programmes
Programme	The course of study for which the student has been admitted into the University. This pertains to Undergraduate (BSc, BA, B.Ed.), Certificates, Diplomas, Advanced Diplomas and Higher Degrees (MA, MSc, MPhil, PhD, etc.).
Qualifying	A student reading for courses to quality for entry to a graduate programme
Registration/Enrolment	The process by which students, upon acceptance into a given faculty and programme at the University, give written notification of the courses which they wish to pursue during the current semester/academic year. Different aspects of the registration data are represented in the tables. For the purpose of this document, this includes both on and off campus students and excludes other students.
Specially Admitted	Students admitted to the University under special circumstances, such as to attend selected courses not associated with a particular programme.
Student Session	Students who are either enrolled in a full time, part time, evening, and summer basis.
Summer	Students enrolled to pursue courses during the summer semester, which occurs, from June to July of the academic year.
Undergraduate (UG)	Students enrolled at the St. Augustine campus in programmes, which lead to the award of a Certificate, UG Diploma or First Degree.
Undeclared	At UWI 'Undeclared' is a level, in addition to UG, GR, CT, etc. used to differentiate students in a non-degree or certificate programme, such as the Pre Science (N1) programme or Pre-Health Professions Programme [PHPP].

Section 1. Trends in the number of Applicants, Offers and New Admissions

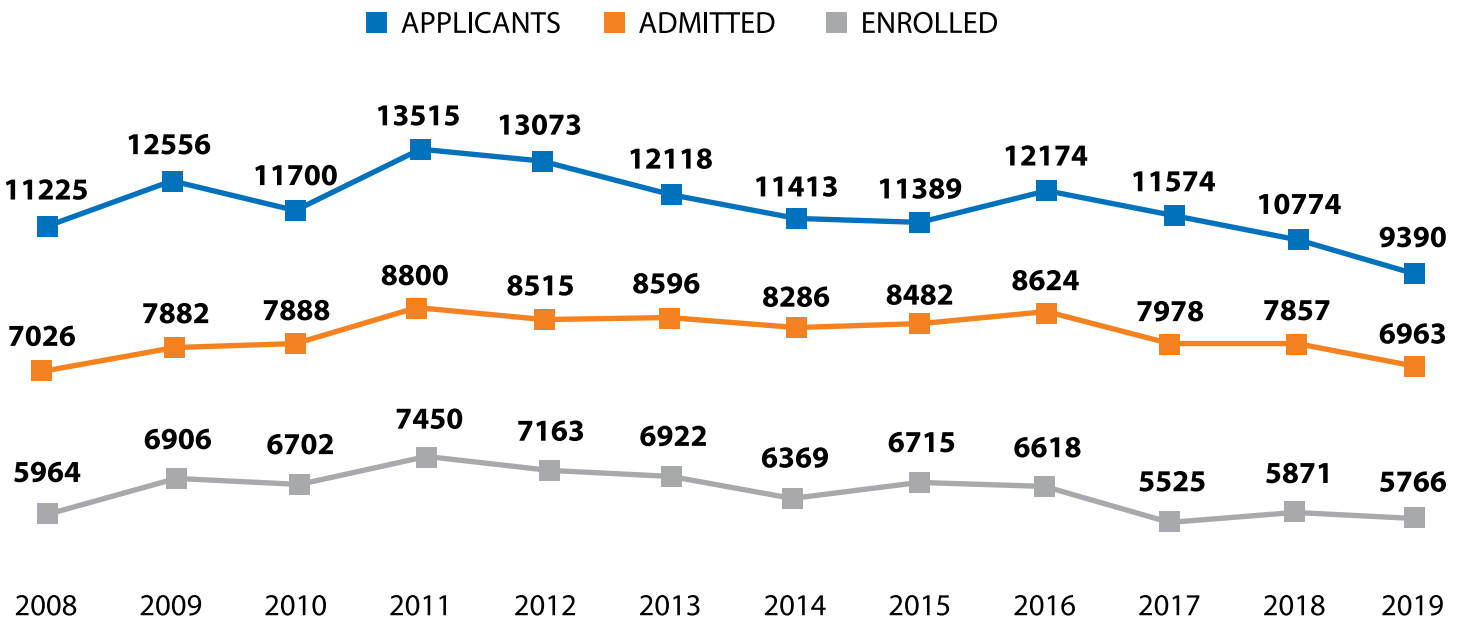
Over a ten year period, the number of applications to the St. Augustine Campus peaked in 2011/2012 at 13,515 but since then applications have declined to 9,390 in 2018/2019. Offers made have shown marginal increases over the time period examined. In terms of the acceptance rate (offers /applications) there has been a moderately increasing trend for the past 3 years, with the current academic year 2019/2020 at 74.2%. A similar trend was observed in respect of yield rates (new admissions/offers) which increased from 74% in 2018/2019 to 82.8% in 2019/2020.

Figure 1.2 - Trends in the proportion of applicants who were offered places 2008/2009 to 2019/2020

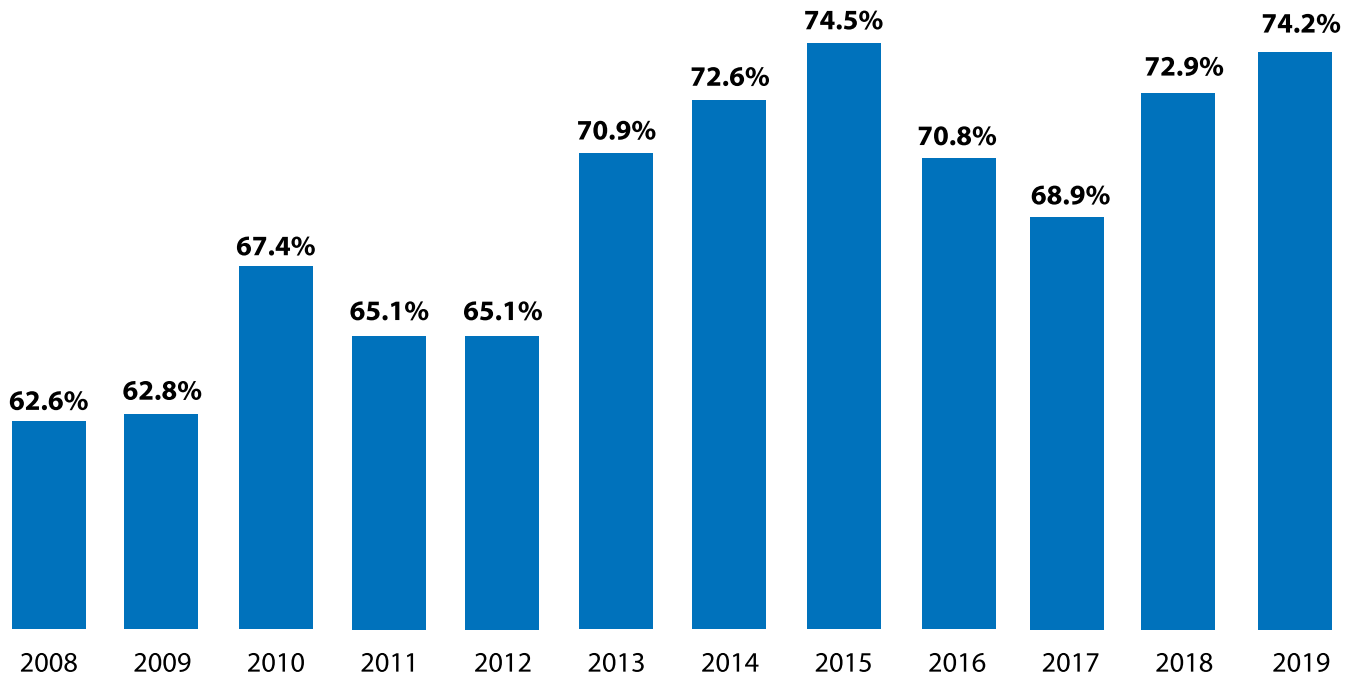
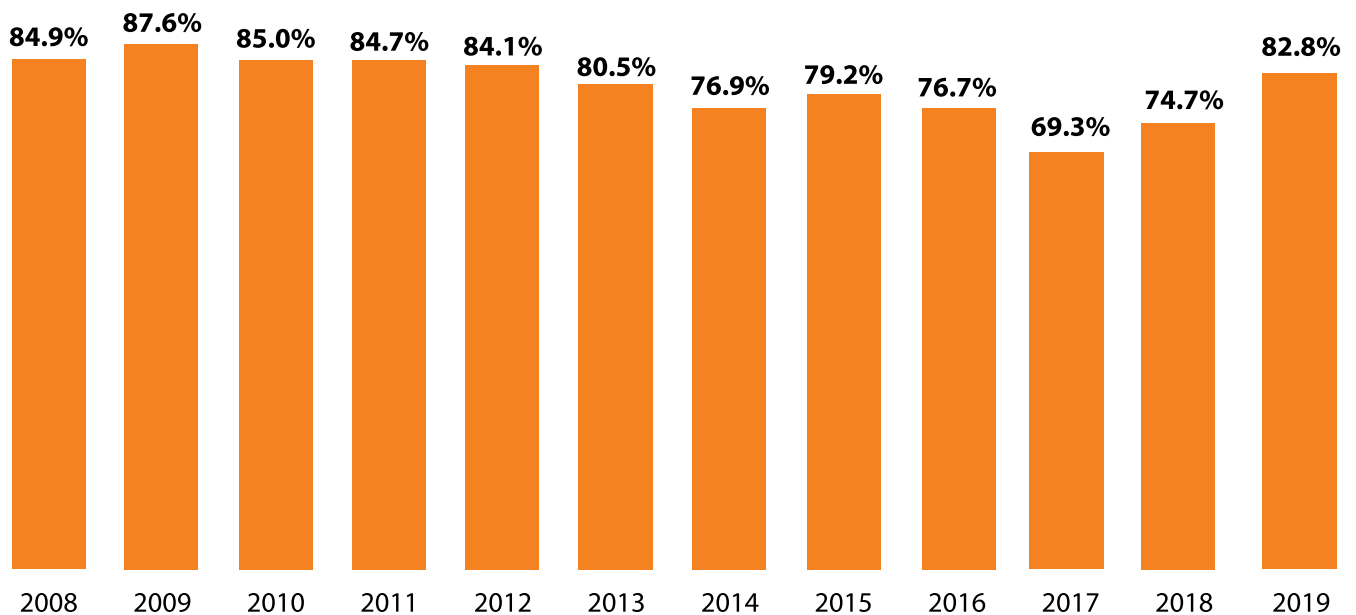


Figure 1.3 - Trends in the proportion of offered applicants who enrolled 2008/2009 to 2019/2020



Section 2. Total Enrolment Trends for UG and PG Students 2014/2015 – 2018/2019

Student enrolment is representative of new and continuing students at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels in the eight faculties of Engineering, Food and Agriculture, Humanities and Education, Law, Medical Sciences, Science and Technology, Social Sciences and Sport.

On average the undergraduate population and postgraduate population constitutes 66.3% and 29.8%, respectively of total enrolment. The trends have however indicated a progressive decline in total student enrolment between the period 2014/2015 to 2018/2019, which has resulted in an overall reduction of 11.1% (See Table 2.2). Pre-University and other students comprise almost 4% of student enrolment. Enrolment by full-time and part-time status is indicated in Table 2.3. For the purpose of Table 2.1 below, the figure for Total Enrolment, situated at the top of the table comprises of both Pre-University students and Other Students. All other tables in this section will provide statistics for the Undergraduate and Post Graduate student populations **only**.

In terms of overall trends in the demographic profile of the student population, for the period 2014/2015 to 2018/2019, at least 63.1% are females.

The majority of the undergraduate student population is in the age cohort of 18 to 24 years. Also at least 92% of the student population are represented by nationals of Trinidad and Tobago, and an approximate 4.8% were from the contributing countries, while those from non-contributing countries represented only 2.9%.

For the purpose of Table 3.1 below, the figure for Total Enrolment, situated at the top of the table comprises of both Pre-University students and Other students. All other tables in this section will show analysis for the Undergraduate and Postgraduate student populations only.

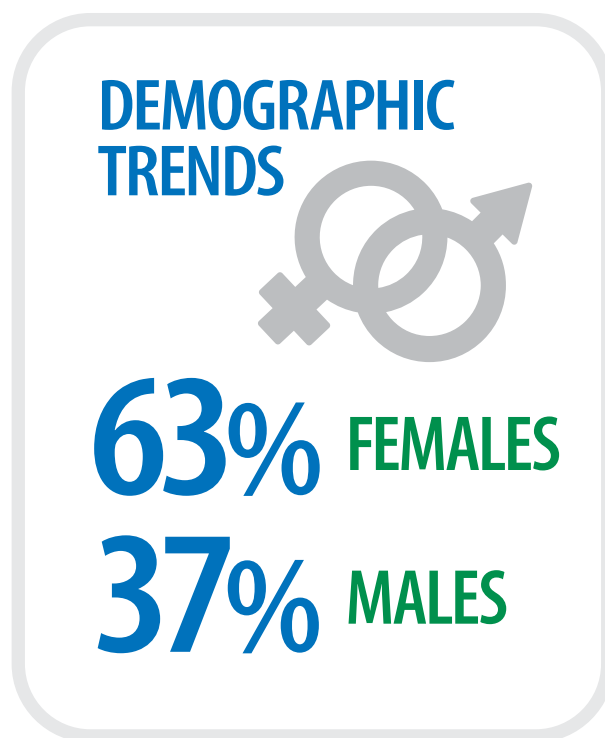

Figure:3.1 Trends in Enrolment by Student Level and Nationality 2014/2015 – 2018/2019

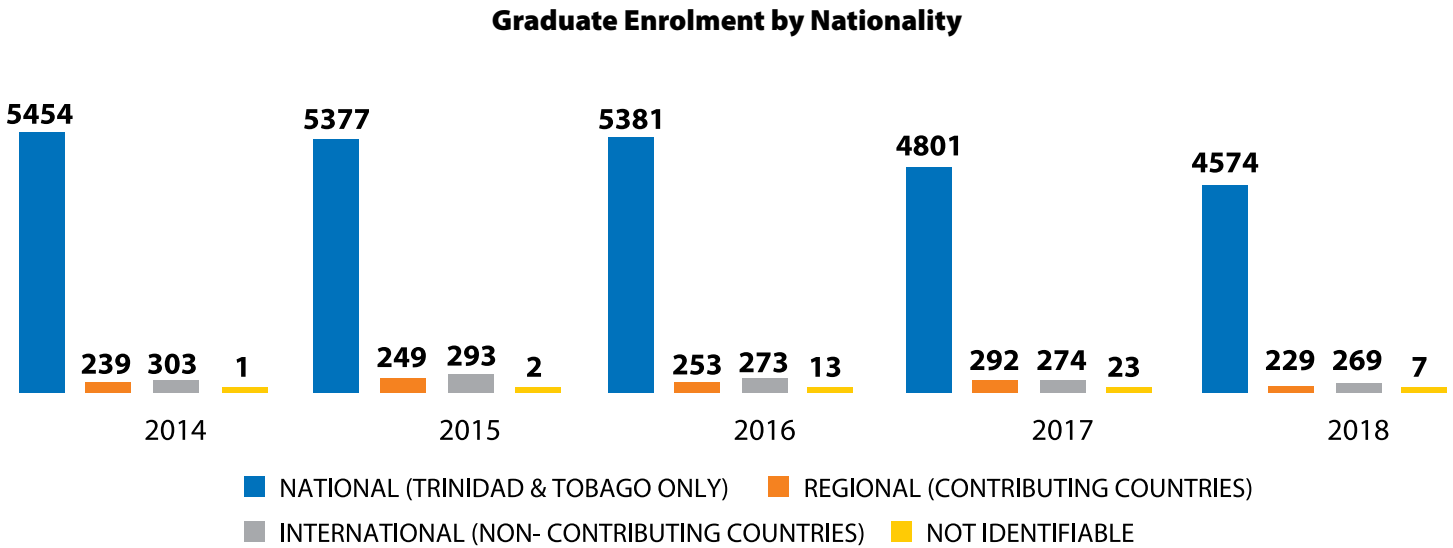
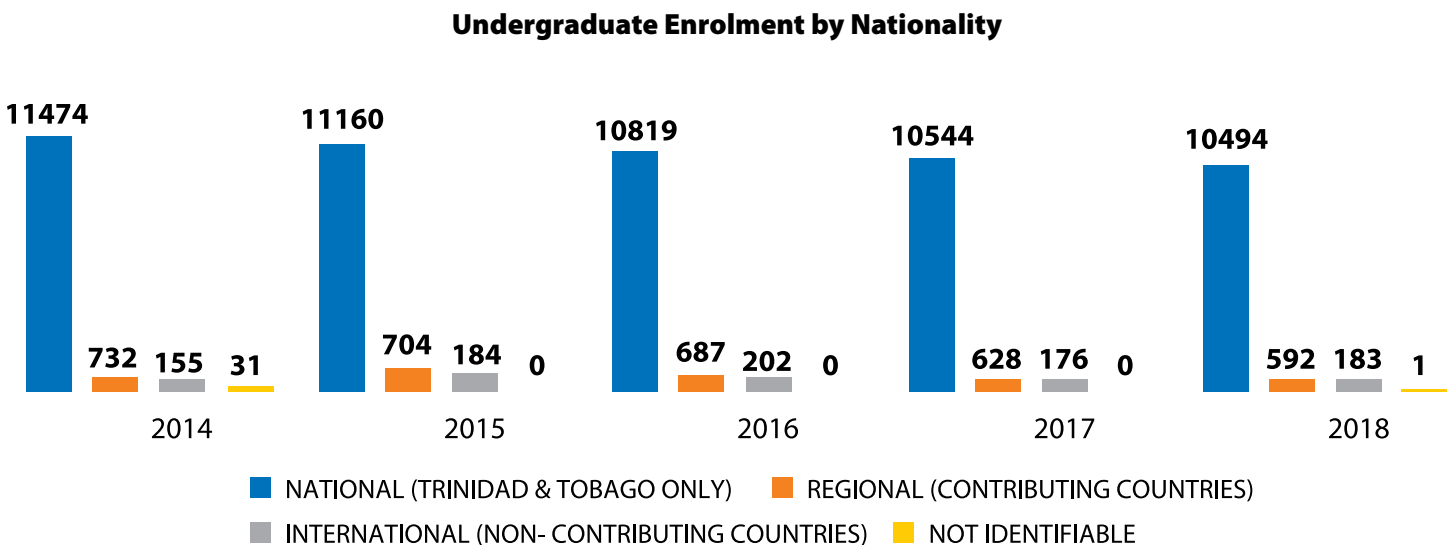


Figure:3.2 Trends in Enrolment by Student Level and Nationality 2014/2015 – 2018/2019

The faculty of Social Sciences continues to be the largest faculty, accounting for approximately one third of the student population. The faculties which follow include Science and Technology and Medical Sciences at 16.3% and 15.7% respectively. The highest proportion of postgraduate enrolment is in the faculty of Social Sciences which in 2018/2019 represents 40% of the total. This is followed by Engineering and Humanities and Education at 17% and 16% respectively.

Figure 4.1: Undergraduate Enrolment by Faculty 2014/2015 – 2018/2019

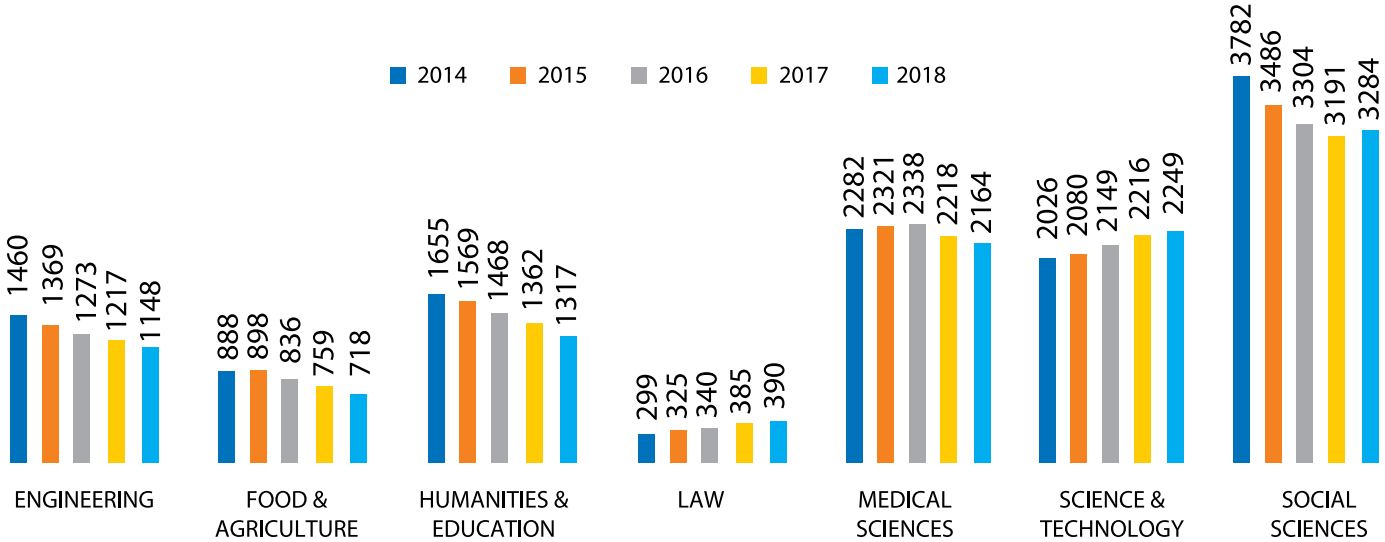
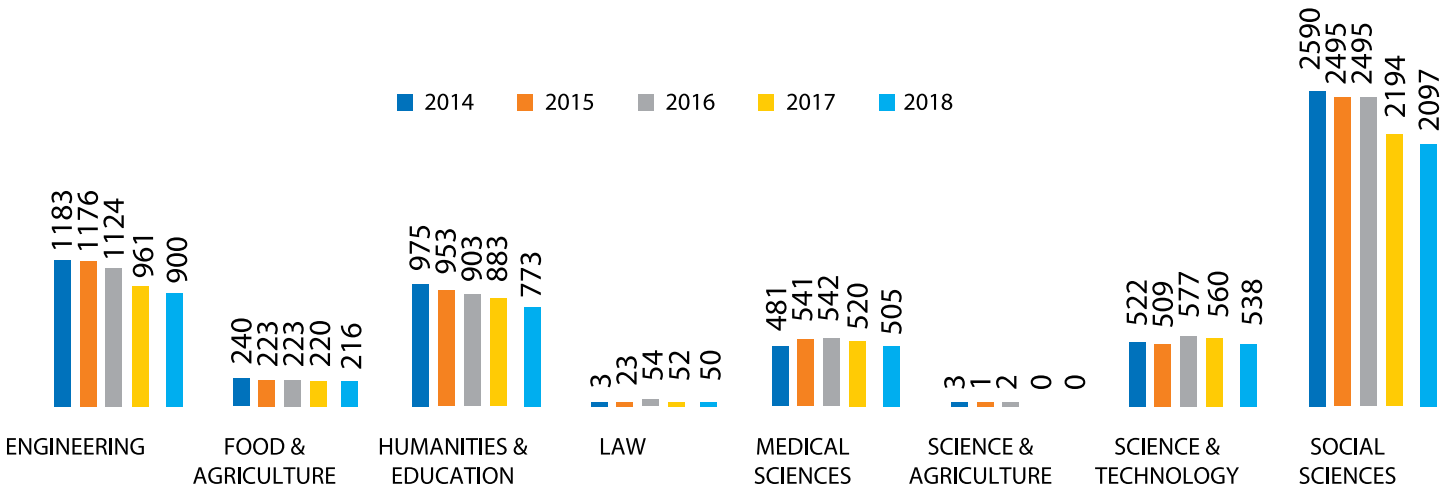


Figure 4.2: Postgraduate Enrolment by Faculty 2014/2015 – 2018/2019

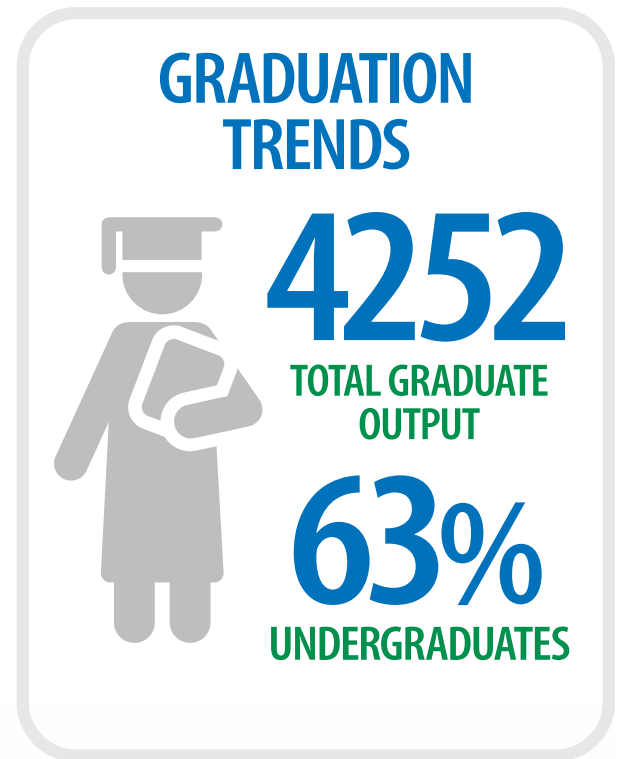
