About the Digest

The University of the West Indies, St. Augustine Campus, presents The Campus Student Statistical Digest for the academic year 2019/2020. The Digest presents a comprehensive collection of official relevant historical and current data on the student population. These statistics cover a five-year academic period (2015/2016 to 2019/2020) and in certain areas, data for Semester 1 of the current academic year 2020/2021. The report examines student admissions, enrolment, graduation and departmental and faculty trends. Also highlighted, are trends in student applications, offers and admissions. Of interest are some key empirical findings emerging from the annual graduate survey of the first-degree graduating class of 2018.

This report is the result of a collaborative effort between the Campus Office of Planning and Institutional Research (COPIR) and the Office of the Campus Registrar, with key input from other units namely, the Student Admissions section, the Office of Graduate Studies and Research (OGSR) and the Examinations section of The UWI St. Augustine Campus. We are grateful as well for the support of the Campus Information Technology Service (CITS) and the Faculties.



Introduction

The University of the West Indies is a four-campus tertiary education institution supported by 17 contributing countries. It offers undergraduate and postgraduate degrees in various fields of study to students from around the region and internationally. The St. Augustine Campus in Trinidad was born in 1960 out of the Imperial College of Tropical Agriculture (ICTA) and typically provides higher education to over 16,000 students. The St. Augustine Campus houses eight faculties: Humanities & Education, Social Sciences, Medical Sciences, Law, Science and Technology, Food and Agriculture and Engineering and the newest being the Faculty of Sport. It also hosts a range of research units, centres and institutes. The UWI, St. Augustine continues to be dedicated to teaching and learning, research and innovation and to the development of the Caribbean region.

This report on The University of the West Indies, St. Augustine Campus is a presentation to the St. Augustine Campus Council for the academic year 2019/2020. The statistical information presented provides quantitative measures and utilises descriptive statistics to illustrate current and historical data on student participation and performance for the period 2015/2016 to 2019/2020. It also provides a snapshot of student statistics for Semester 1 of the current academic year, 2020/2021. This report delivers information on the following areas:

- a. **Student statistics over a five-year period in respect of Student Applications Admissions, Enrolment and Graduation**
- b. **Faculty statistical comparisons**
- c. **A demographic profile of students by nationality, age and sex**
- d. **Student enrolment at the programme level**

This document was produced with Enrolment data that was generated on November 17th, 2020 and Graduation data generated on December 12th, 2020. As such, any updates made to data subsequent to the aforementioned dates would not be reflected in the statistics presented.

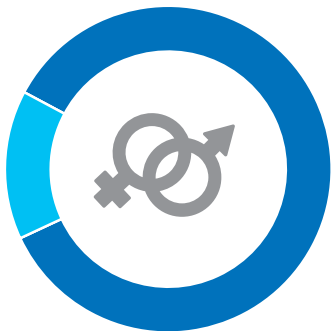

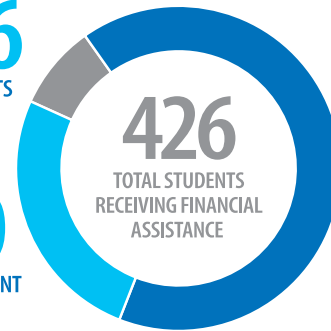

Definitions of Key Terms and Concepts

Acceptance Rate	The percentage of applicants who received official offers from the St. Augustine Campus.
Applications	The number of applications received from individuals (head count)
Contributing Students	Students whose country of nationality include the UWI 12 +1 as well as Barbados, Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago
Evening	Students who are registered in Certificate/Diploma or Degree programmes which are offered specifically in the Evening University
Full-Time	Registered students who carry the complete load of course credits associated with their university programme for that semester/academic year
Nationals	Students whose country of nationality is Trinidad & Tobago.
New Admissions	Registered students who are new first-time entrants and new first-time transfers to the University.
No College Designated	Students who are in enrolled in Summer Programmes who are registered with a particular faculty
Non-Contributing	Students whose country of nationality includes all nations other than the UWI 12+1, Barbados, Jamaica or Trinidad & Tobago.
Not Identifiable (NI)	Used to categorised any area where no data was entered in the data repository
Offers	The number of applicants (head count) given institutional acceptance (offers)
Off Campus	Students enrolled in programmes that are administered at UWI-affiliated institutions and are not located in the host country, that is Trinidad & Tobago.
On Campus	Students who attend classes on the St. Augustine or Mt. Hope campuses and are in pursuit of a degree, certificate or diploma programme.
Other Students	Students enrolled in undeclared courses and summer programmes
Part-Time	Registered students who carry less than the complete load of courses associated with their university programme for that semester/academic year
Postgraduate (PG)	Students enrolled in Higher Degree programmes at the St. Augustine Campus which lead to the acquisition of a qualification beyond a first degree such as the PG Diploma, Taught Master, Master of Philosophy, Doctorate etc.
Pre-University Students	Students enrolled in the Pre-Science, Pre-Health and Pre-Engineering programmes
Programme	The course of study for which the student has been admitted into the University. This pertains to Undergraduate (BSc, BA, B.Ed.), Certificates, Diplomas, Advanced Diplomas and Higher Degrees (MA, MSc, MPhil, PhD, etc.).
Qualifying	A student reading for courses to qualify for entry to a postgraduate programme
Registration/Enrolment	The process by which students, upon acceptance into a given faculty and programme at the University, give written notification of the courses which they wish to pursue during the current semester/academic year. Different aspects of the registration data are represented in the tables. For the purpose of this document, this includes both on and off campus students and excludes other students.
Specially Admitted	Students admitted to the University under special circumstances, such as to attend selected courses not associated with a particular programme.
Student Session	Students who are either enrolled in a full time, part time, evening, and summer basis.
Summer	Students enrolled to pursue courses during the summer semester, which occurs, from June to July of the academic year.
Undergraduate (UG)	Students enrolled at the St. Augustine Campus in programmes, which lead to the award of a Certificate, UG Diploma or First Degree.
Undeclared	At UWI 'Undeclared' is a level, in addition to UG, GR, CT, etc. used to differentiate students in a non-degree or certificate programme, such as the Pre-Science (N1) programme or Pre-Health Professions Programme [PHPP].
Yield Rate	The percentage of students that, upon receipt of an offer, choose to be enrolled at the St. Augustine Campus. The rate is commonly used as a measure of selectivity indicating interest in a particular institution.

Section 1 – Trends in the Number of Applications, Offers, and New Admissions

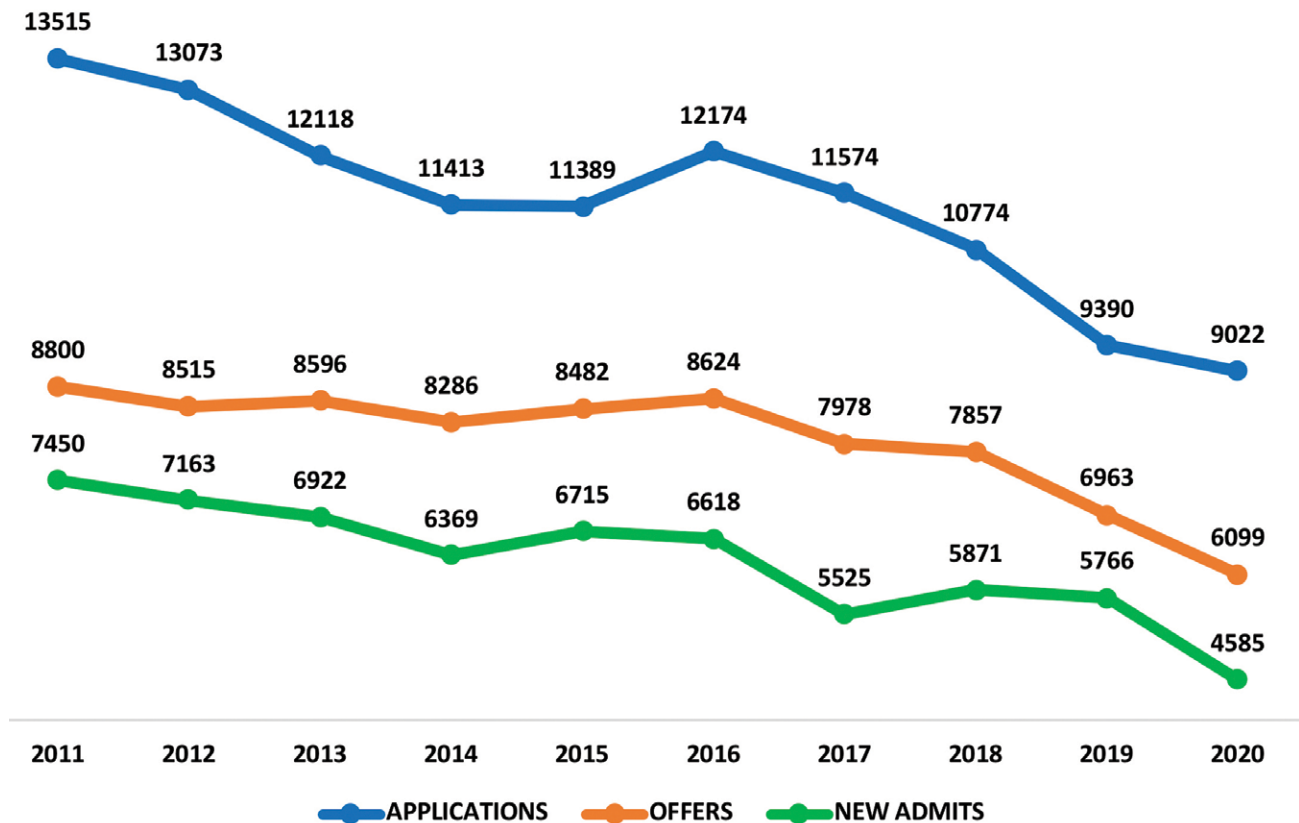
Figure 1.1 below illustrates undergraduate and postgraduate trends for applications, offers and new admissions over a ten-year period. The number of applications to the St. Augustine Campus peaked in 2011/2012 at 13,515 but since then applications have declined to 9,022 in 2020/2021. Offers made have shown marginal increases over the time period 2011/2012 to 2016/2017, thereafter, offers made have been on the decline. In terms of acceptance rates (offers/applications), there has been an increasing trend from 2017/2018 to 2019/2020, however there has been a decrease in 2020/2021 to 67.6% when compared to 74.2% in the previous year. This is mainly attributed to the circumstances brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic which created a degree of uncertainty amongst applicants. This also impacted on yield rates (new admissions/offers) which showed a similar trend where there was a decline from 82.8% in 2019/2020 to 75.2% in 2020/2021.

Figure 1.2: Trends in Acceptance Rates 2011/2012 – 2020/2021

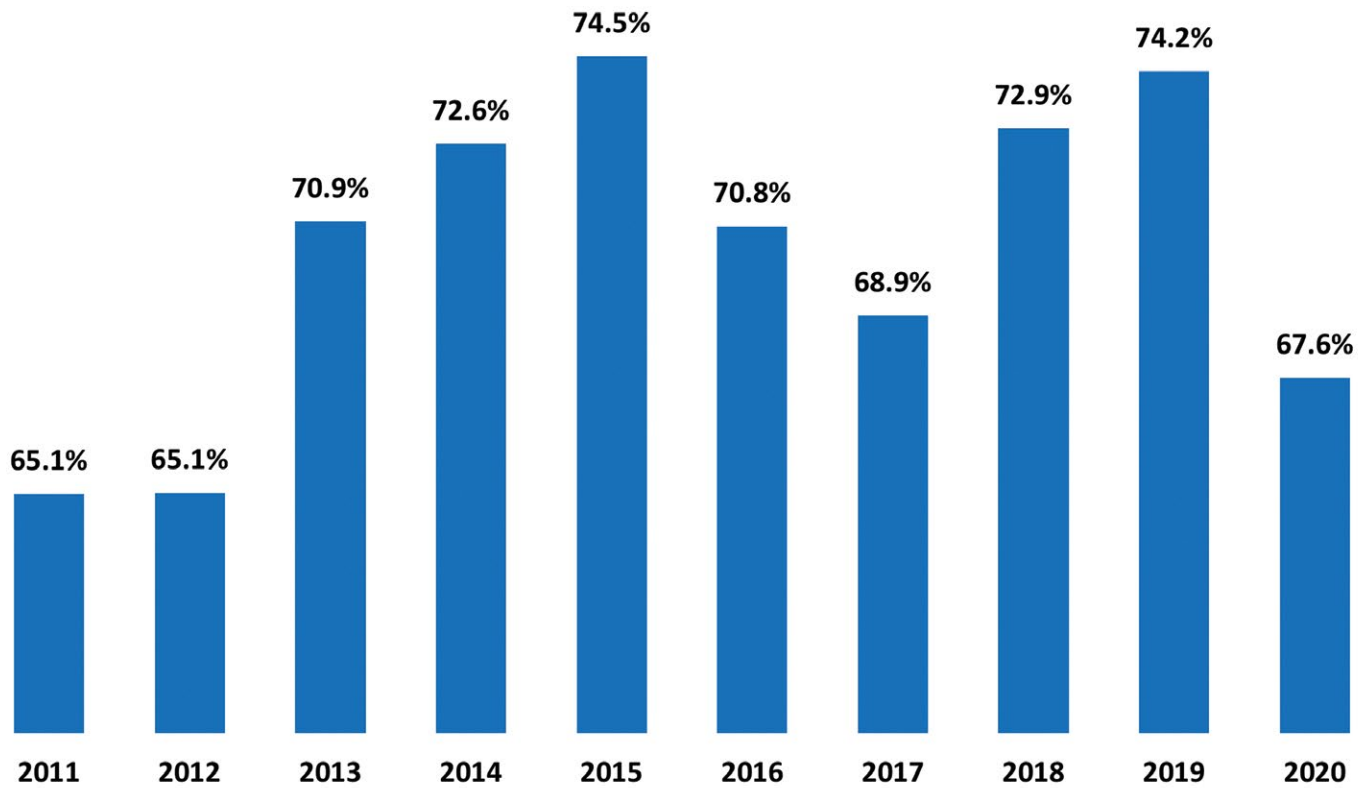
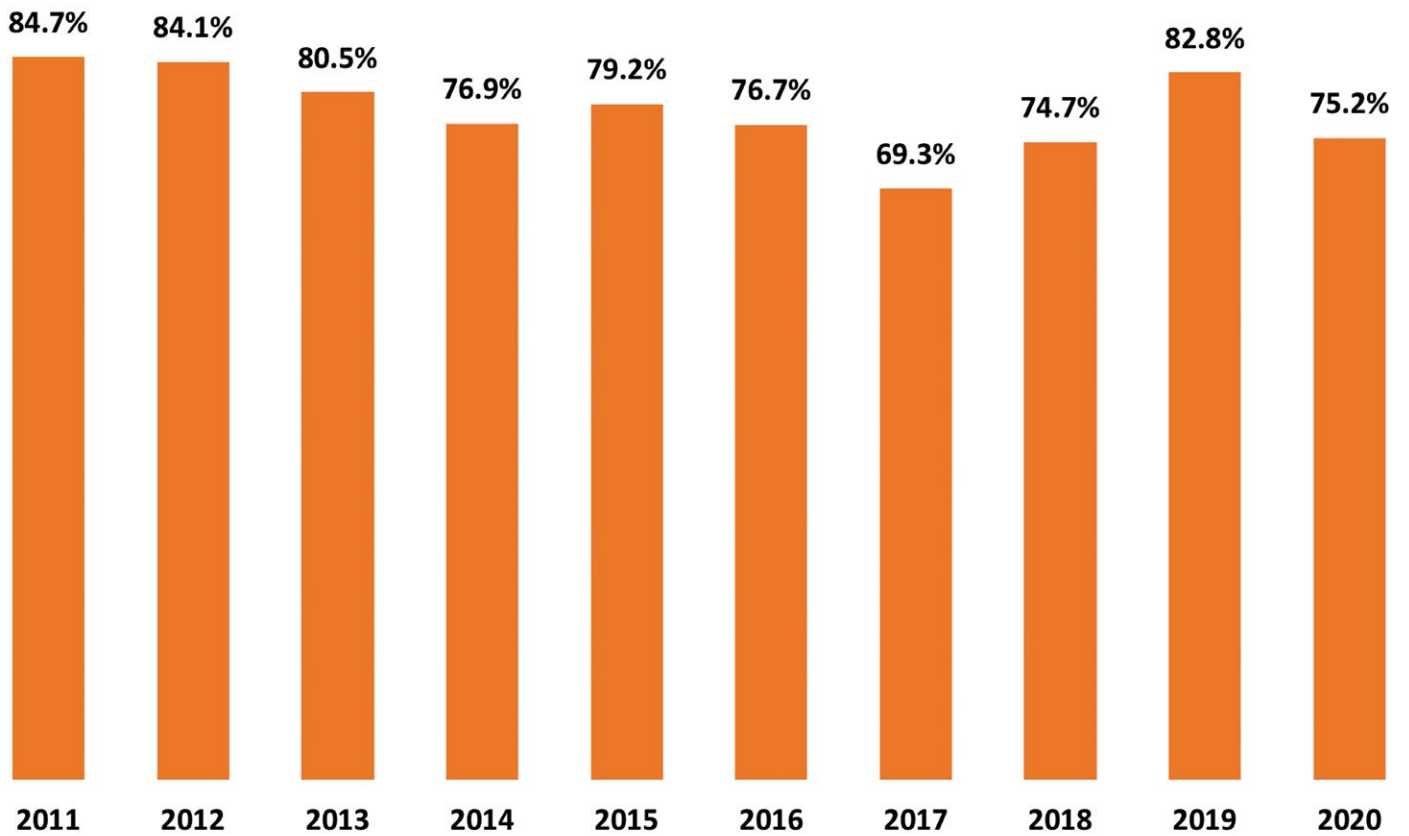


Figure 1.3: Trends in Yield Rates 2011/2012 – 2020/2021



Section 2 – Total Enrolment Trends for UG and PG Students 2015/2016 to 2019/2020

Student enrolment is representative of new and continuing students at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels in the eight (8) faculties of Engineering, Food and Agriculture, Humanities and Education, Law, Medical Sciences, Science and Technology, Social Sciences and Sport.

In 2019/2020, the undergraduate population and postgraduate population constituted **67.5% and 28.8%**, respectively of total enrolment. The trends have however indicated a progressive decline in total student enrolment between the period 2015/2016 to 2019/2020, which resulted in an overall reduction of 10.3% (See Table 2.2). Pre-University and Other students comprise almost 4% of student enrolment. Enrolment by full-time and part-time status is indicated in Table 2.3. For the purpose of Table 2.1 below, the figure for Total Enrolment, situated at the top of the table comprises both Pre-University students and Other Students. All other tables in this section will provide statistics for the Undergraduate and Post Graduate student populations only.

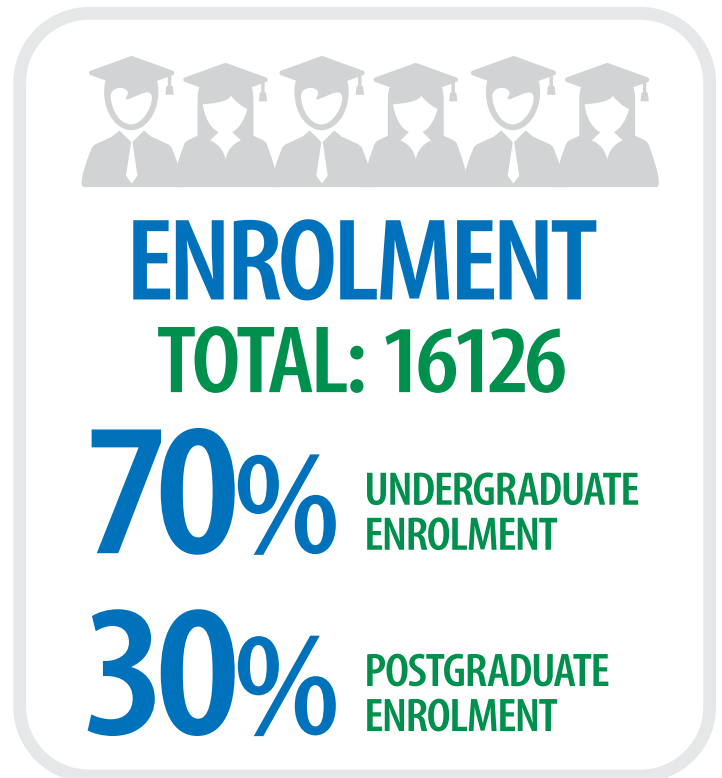
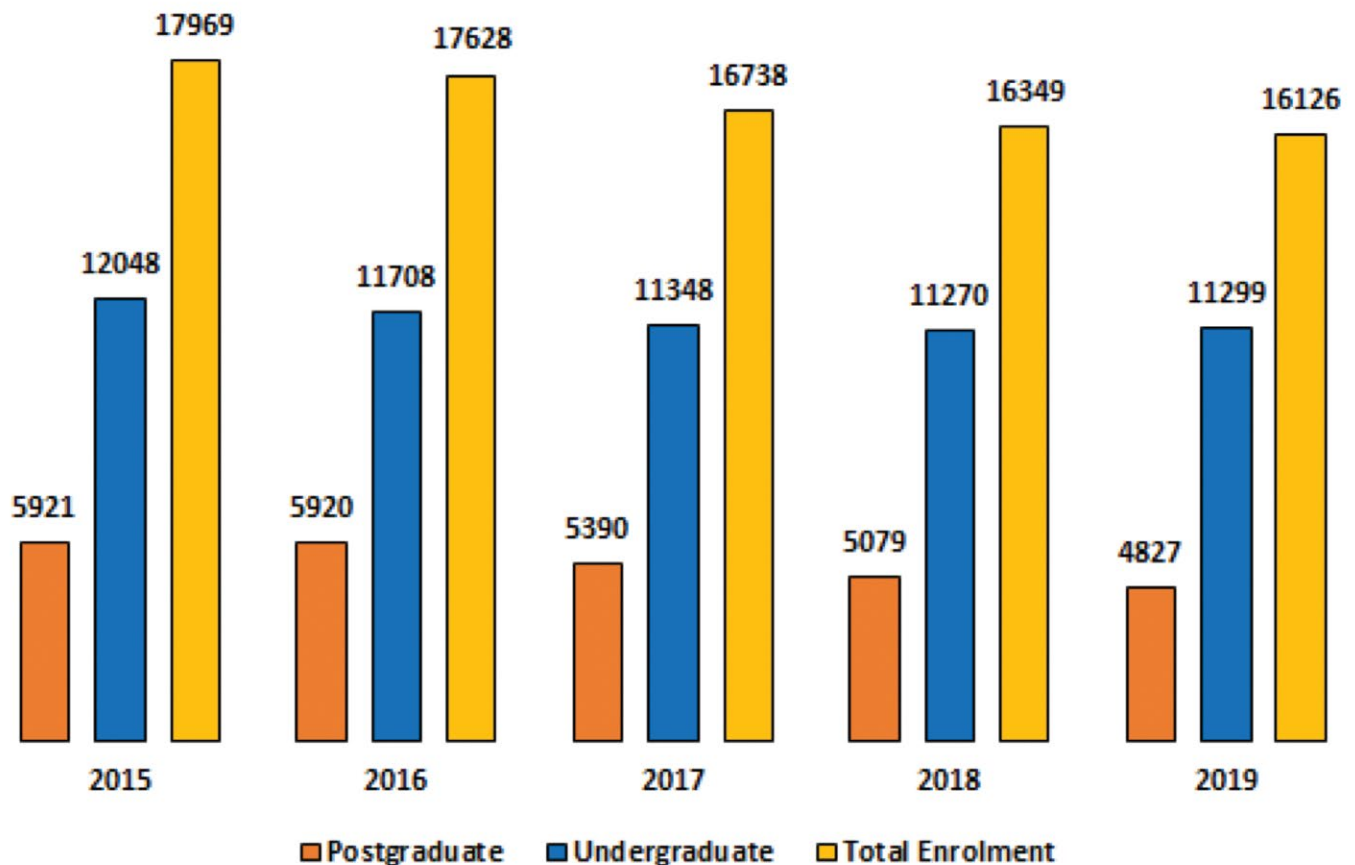


Figure 2.1: Enrolment Trends for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Students 2015/2016 to 2019/2020

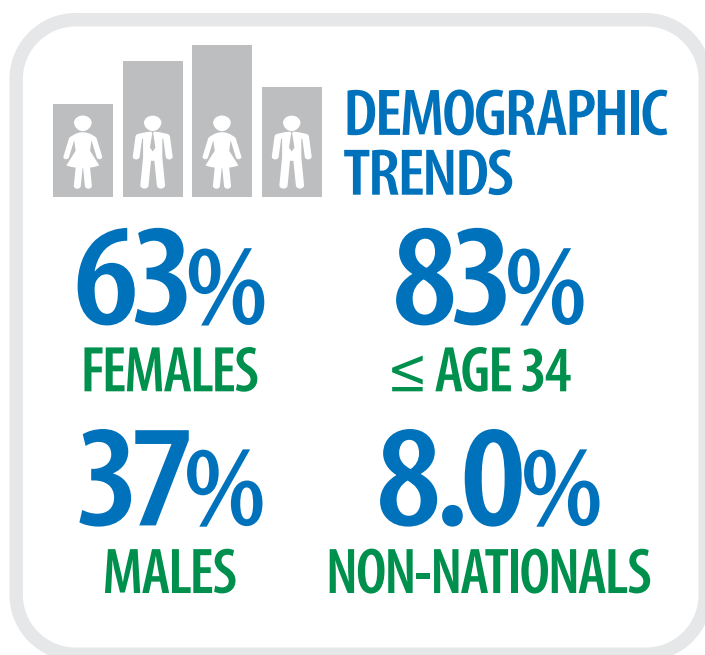

Figure 3.1: Trends in Enrolment by Student Level and Nationality 2015/2016 – 2019/2020

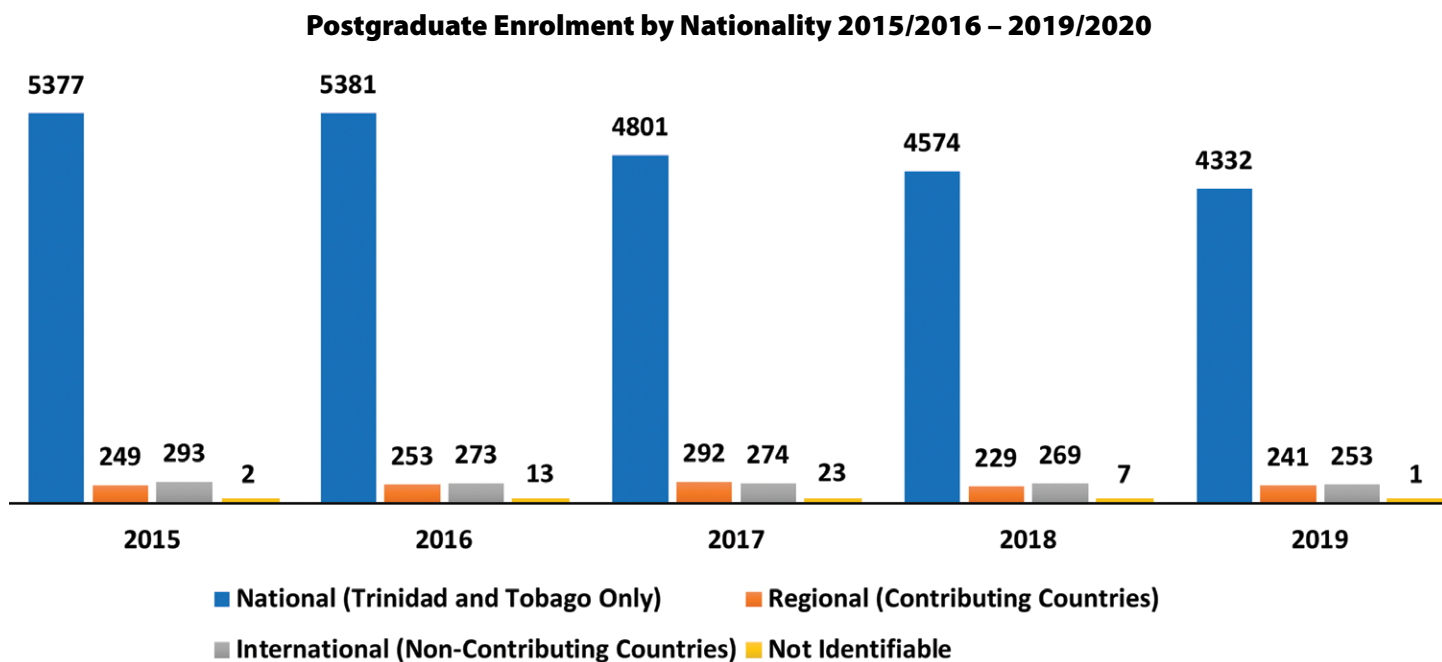
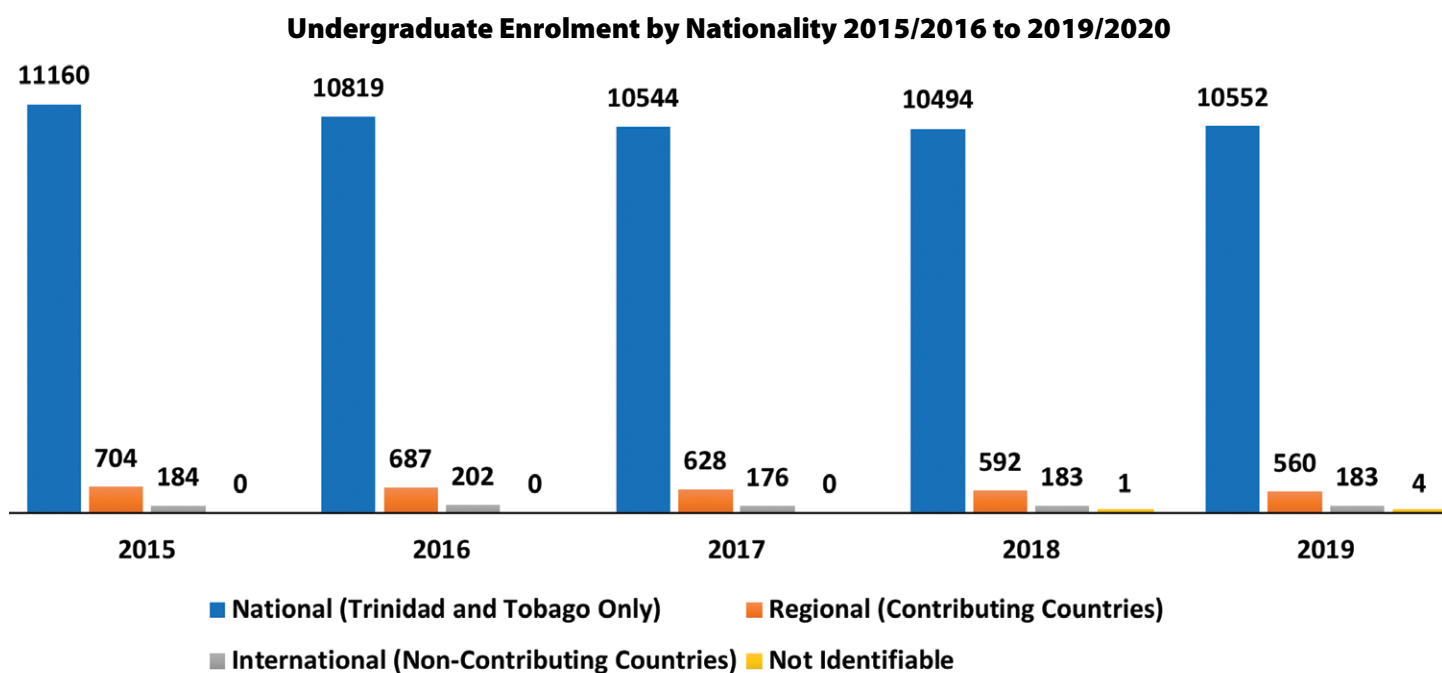


Figure 3.2: Trends in Enrolment by Student Level and Nationality 2015/2016 – 2019/2020

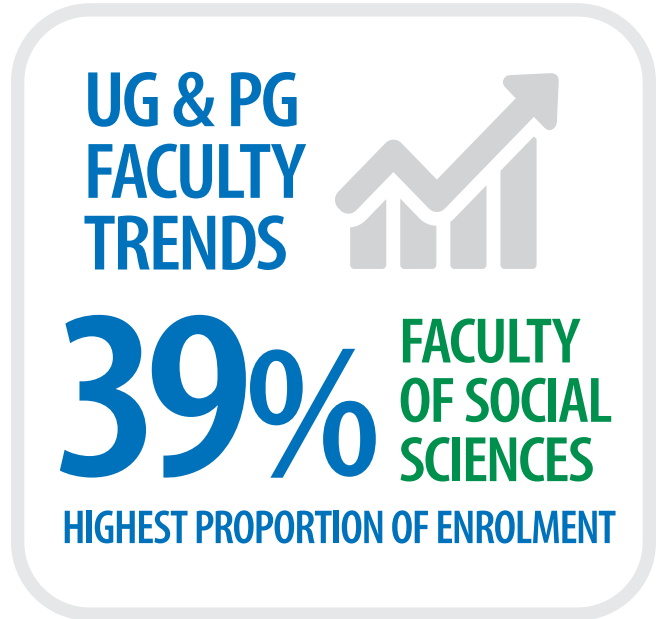

Figure 4.1: Postgraduate Enrolment by Faculty 2015/2016 – 2019/2020

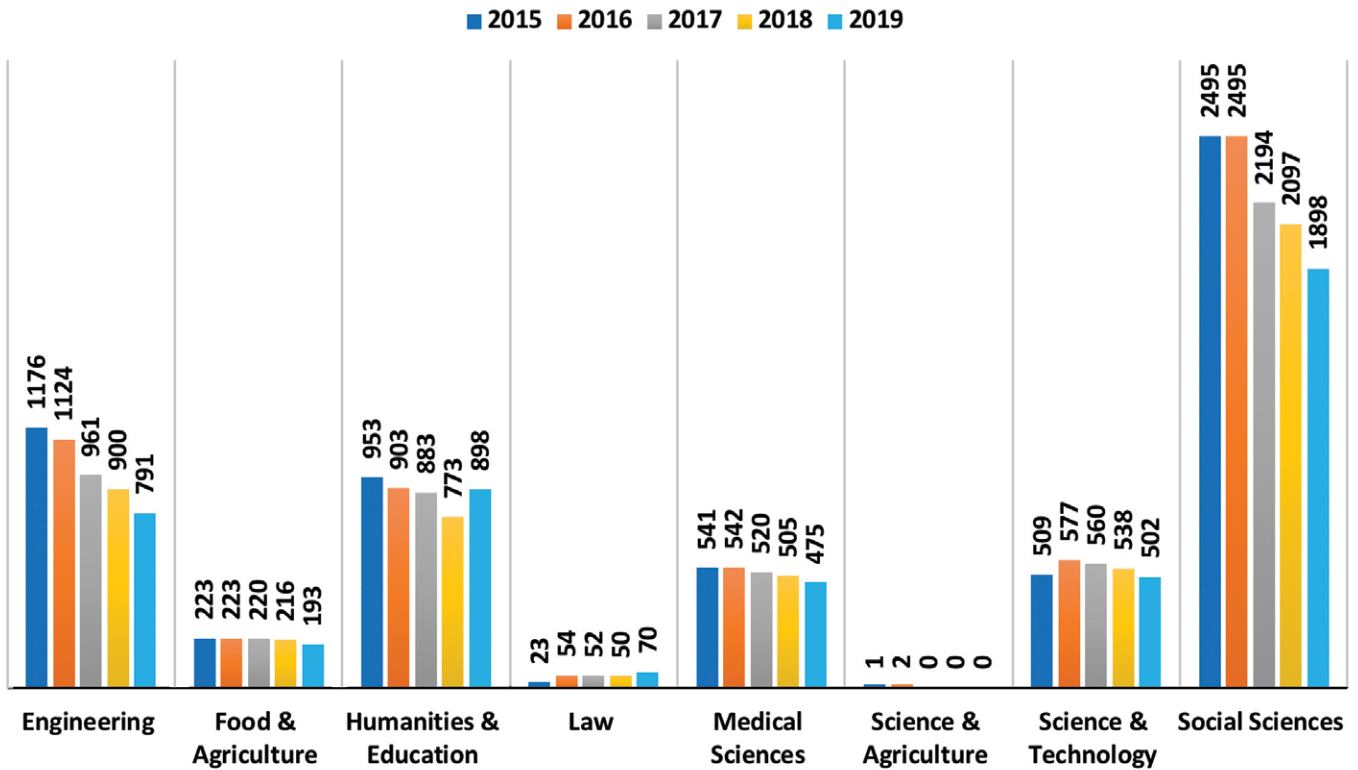
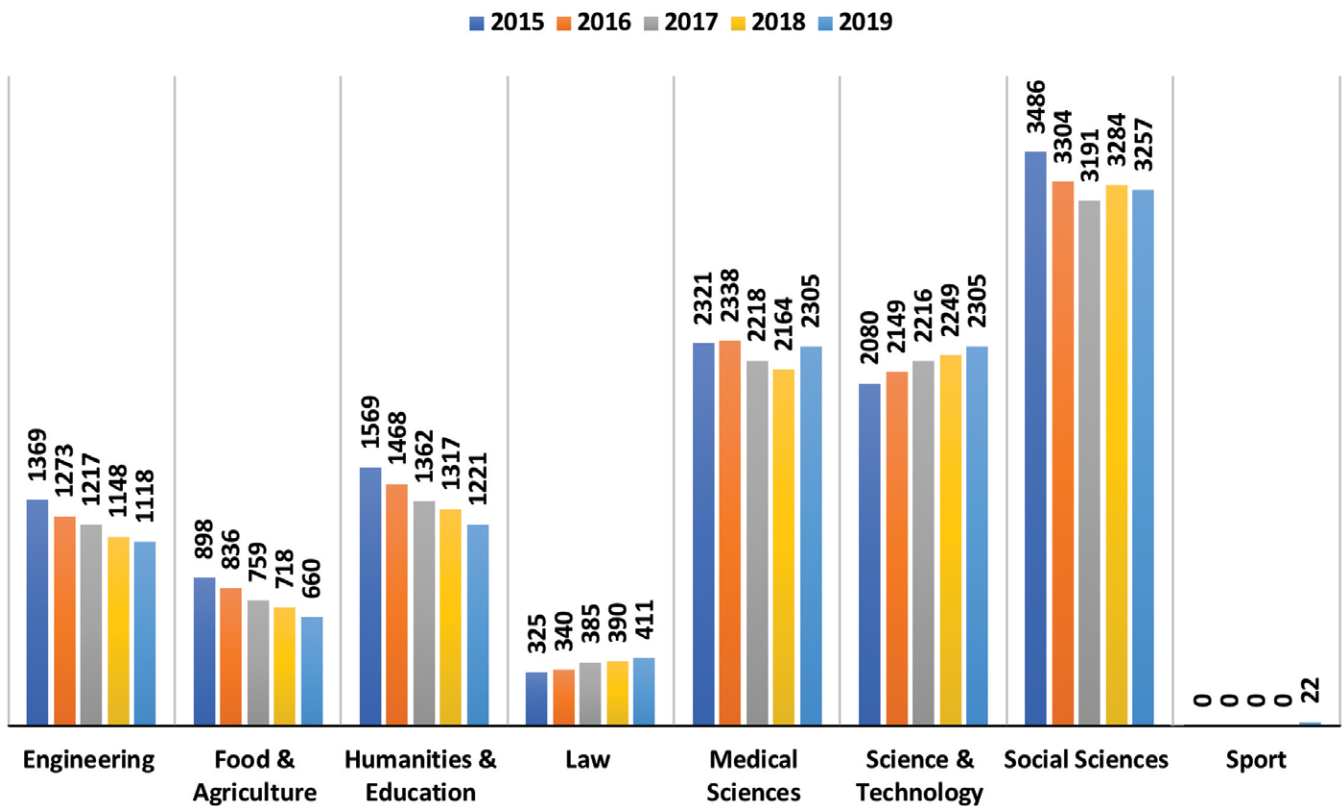


Figure 4.2: Undergraduate Enrolment by Faculty 2015/2016 – 2019/2020

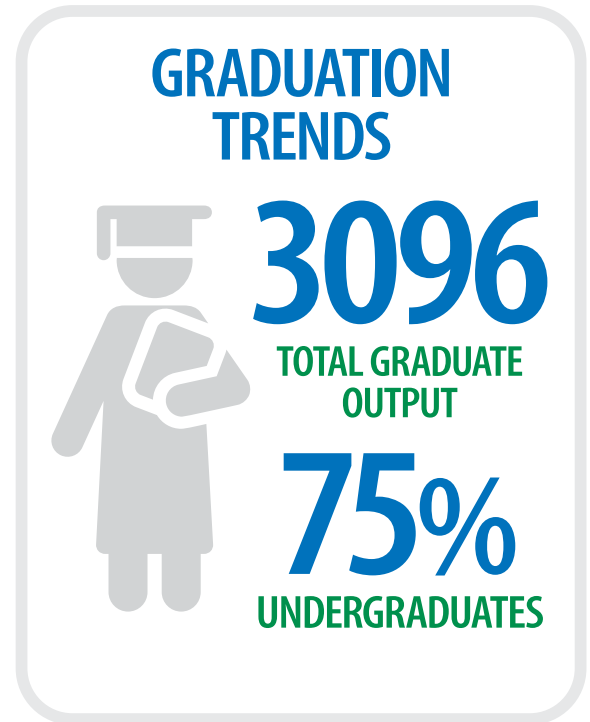

Section 5 – Undergraduate and Postgraduate Graduation Trends

This section provides data on graduate output in respect of demographics, faculty, degree honours and graduate throughput. Highlighted below are some observations related to graduate output over the period to 2019/2020:

- A total of 3096 persons graduated in 2019/2020 of which 74.5% were first degree graduates and 17.5% were higher degree graduates. This represented a decline from the previous year of 2018/2019 when there was a graduate output of 4252 graduates. Once more, the COVID-19 pandemic impacted on the number of persons graduating in the period under review.
- The programmes which awarded the highest number of graduates in 2020 included Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor Surgery; Bachelor Management Studies; Bachelor of Law at the first-degree level Master of Business Administration; Master of Public Sector Management; Master of Project Management and Master of Law at the graduate taught master's level.

Information extracted from the annual Graduate Tracer Survey of first-degree graduates of 2018 are presented below. The feedback received from graduates are captured one year post graduation and presents an indication of the sectors of their employment, the main areas of economic activity of their employers, the time taken to find employment and the salary ranges earned.

Figure 5.1: Respondents by Sector of Employment

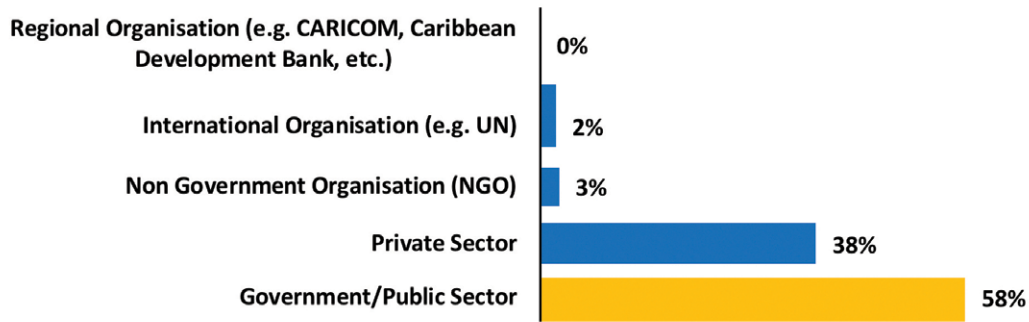
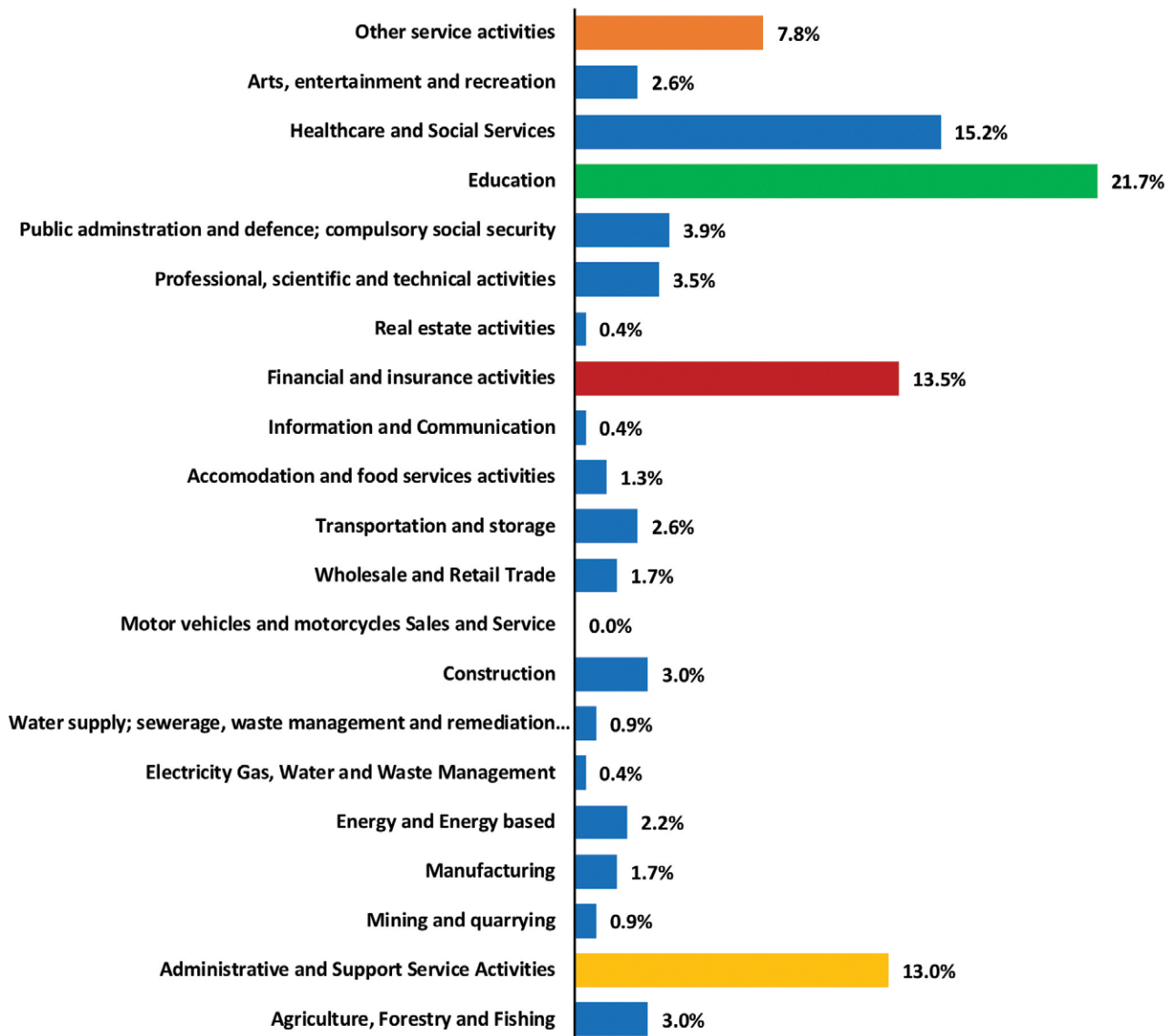


Figure 5.2: Respondents by Employers Areas of Activity

Figure 5.3: Respondents' Mean Time in Months Taken to Find Employment

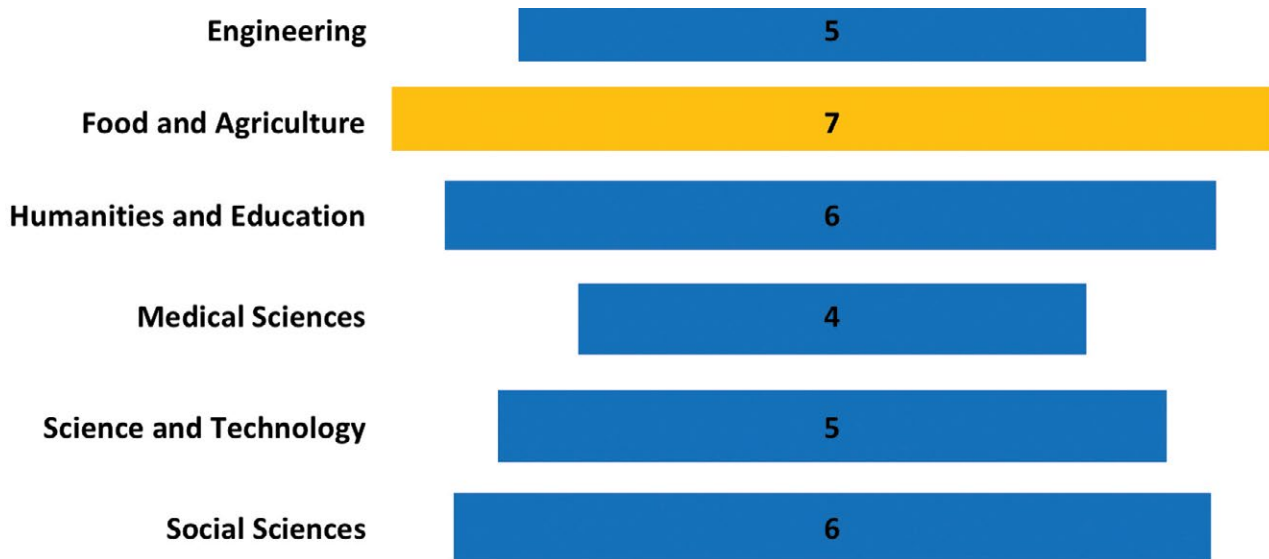
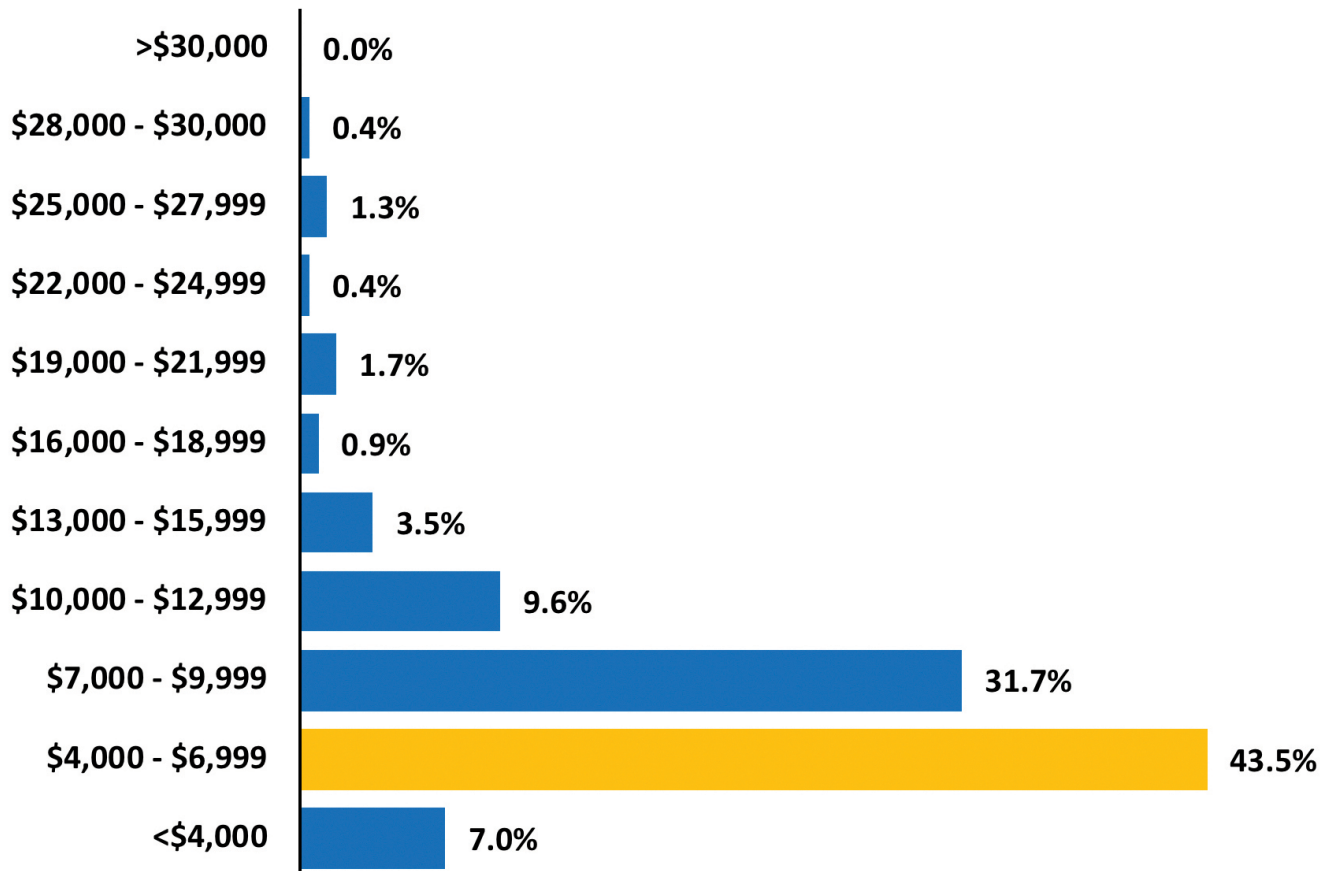


Figure 5.4: Respondents' Salary Range (TT\$)
